WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Following are the texts of cables Senator Bob Dole sent last night to Israeli Prime Minister Menahem Begin and Egyptian President Anwar Sadat:

YOUR DRAMATIC INITIATIVE TOWARD ISRAEL OFFERS AN UNPRECEDENTED OPPORTUNITY FOR A PEACEFUL RESOLUTION OF DIFFERENCES IN THE MIDDLE EAST.

THIS IS AN ACT OF COURAGE AND STATECRAFT WHICH WILL SURELY BE APPLAUDED BY ALL PEACE-LOVING PEOPLE, AND ONE WHICH BRINGS HOPE NOT JUST FOR PEACE IN THE HOLY LAND, BUT FOR STABILITY IN THE WORLD.
