SENATOR DOLE APPOINTED TO BOARD OF VISITORS OF THE U.S. MILITARY ACADEMY

WASHINGTON-- Senator Bob Dole (R.-Kansas) was recently appointed to the Board of Visitors of the United States Military Academy at West Point, New York.

The Board of Visitors is comprised of four U.S. Senators, five members of the House of Representatives and six Presidential appointees. They meet on a regular basis to oversee matters relating to the Academy, including educational philosophy, cirriculum, fiscal affairs and morale.

"I am deeply honored to be chosen for this position, "Senator Dole said. "West Point has a tremendous history and has played a unique role in ensuring that our nation is prepared in time of war.
