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GSA PROCUREMENT CLINICS TO BE HELD IN TOPEKA, WICHITA IN JULY

WASHINGTON-- Representatives of the General Services Administration's Kansas City Regional Office will be conducting procurement clinics in Wichita and Topeka on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday; July 18, 19 and 20, Senator Bob Dole (R.-Kansas) announced today.
