DOLE PLANS BUSY SCHEDULE DURING AUGUST SENATE RECESS

WASHINGTON-- Senator Bob Dole (R.-Kansas) will be a busy individual during the August recess period, which begins on Friday, August 3rd.

Dole will be visiting 16 states and 31 different cities during the break. The Kansas Republican is an announced contender for the 1980 GOP presidential nomination.

Dole will be giving a major address at the National Press Club at noon on August 7 in Washington, D.C. and is expected to offer his views on leadership and the energy situation.

Senator Dole will be in Kansas on Tuesday, August 21, Wednesday, August 22, and Monday, August 27. On the latter date he will be in Hutchinson for the annual Kansas Livestock Association meeting.

States that Dole will visit include Iowa, Florida, Illinois, Texas, California, Oregon, Missouri, Massachusetts, Maine, Rhode Island, Colorado, Alabama, Nebraska and New York.
