DOLE, KASSEBAUM ANNOUNCE EDUCATION FUNDS FOR KANSAS

WASHINGTON -- Kansas Senators Bob Dole and Nancy Kassebaum today announced that the U.S. Department of Education has awarded the State of Kansas two grants, totaling \$61,200.

The larger grant, totaling \$48,000, is to be used for handicapped personnel preparation. The funds will go to improving quality and increasing the supply of teachers, speech correctionists, physical education and recreation specialists, and other special personnel, as well as the training of regular education teachers, supervisors and administrators.

The other grant, totaling \$13,200, will provide for direct and indirect technical assistance and training services to school districts to cope with educational problems caused by desegregation by race, sex, and national origin.
