DOLE SEES RENEWED WHEAT SALES TO CHINA

"IN THE NEAR FUTURE"

WASHINGTON -- Senator Bob Dole (R.-Kan.) today said that he expects the People's Republic of China (PRC) to renew purchases of U.S. wheat "in the near future."

"The Chinese have made it clear that their cutoff of purchases of U.S. grain was directly tied to the long impasse over textile import quotas," said Senator Dole.

"With the resolution of the textile dispute on Saturday, I would expect China to be back in our wheat markets in the near future," Dole said.
