## DOLE ON GENEVA ARMS CONTROL MEETING

WASHINGTON -Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole (R-KS) today released the following statement concerning today's arms control meeting in Geneva:

"I am pleased that the talks in Geneva between Secretary Shultz and Foreign Minister Gromyko have yielded an agreement to begin more concrete talks on the control and reduction of nuclear weapons. I agree with Secretary Shultz's characterization in Geneva: this is an important beginning. All of us are hopeful that the days ahead will bring real progress, but we must all remember that this is likely to be a hard and complex set of negotiations. Our hopes must be tempered by realism and patience."
