DOLE NAMES THREE TO HOLOCAUST COUNCIL

WASHINGTON -- Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole (R-Kans.) today announced the appointment of three Senate members to the U.S. Holocaust Memorial Council.

The Council is an honorary federal commission dedicated to the commemoration of the victims of the Holocaust through special events and the privately-funded Holocaust Museum in Washington, D.C.
