NEW PRESS SECRETARY JOINS DOLE'S STAFF

WASHINGTON -- Kansas Senator Bob Dole today announced that Brent N. Bahler has been added to the Senator's press staff to handle Kansas media. Bahler succeeds Scott Richardson, who accepted a communications position in the private sector.
