SEN. DOLE ANNOUNCES STAFF CHANGES

(Wichita, KS) -- Senator Bob Dole today announced staff changes in his Washington and Wichita offices.

Steve Coen, Kansas administrative assistant for the past four years, will be moving to the Washington, DC, office and assuming new duties as a legislative assistant for energy, environment and commerce related issues.

Coen, 32, is a graduate of Emporia State University and Washburn University Law School. He is a former partner in the law firm of Shields and Coen in St. John, and was a member of Sen. Dole's 1980 re-election staff before joining the Senator's staff in Wichita in March, 1982.

Greg Schnacke, Topeka, has been named Coen's replacement as regional representative. Schnacke, 27, graduated from the University of Kansas in 1981 and received his Juris Doctorate from the University of Tulsa in 1984.

While at K.U., Schnacke was elected student body president and senior class president. He was also named "Outstanding Graduating Senior in Energy Law" upon graduation from law school. He most recently has been affiliated with Gauer and Breuning Productions in Tulsa.

Schnacke's responsibilities will include traveling throughout Kansas on behalf of Sen. Dole, and working with constituents out of the Wichita office.
