DOLE ANNOUNCES BLOCK GRANTS FOR OVERLAND PARK

Washington, D.C. -- Overland Park has been awarded a federal grant of more than \$300,000 to assist in the upkeep of neighborhood homes and streets, Kansas Senator Bob Dole today announced.

The \$331,000 Community Development Block Grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development will be used by the City of Overland Park for housing rehabilitation and weatherization, neighborhood curbs and gutters, and for minor home repairs.

Community Development Block Grants are authorized under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. Block grants are awarded to various cities throughout the country based on need, and then spent by the cities on projects that benefit lower and moderate income residents.
