DOLE APPOINTS LORETTA FULLER SERGEANT-AT-ARMS POST

WASHINGTON -- SENATE REPUBLICAN LEADER BOB DOLE (R-KS.) TODAY ANNOUNCED THE APPOINTMENT OF LORETTA FULLER TO EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT TO THE SENATE THE SERGEANT-AT-ARMS OFFICE, BEGINNING MONDAY, MARCH 2.

Since 1981, Ms. Fuller has worked for Senator Steve Symms as Office Manager, Executive Secretary, and Director of Fund Raising. She also served as Executive Assistant and Office Manager when Symms was a Member of the House of Representatives.

Ms. Fuller managed scheduling, personal appearances, correspondence and all financial accounts and operations for Senator Symms. The daughter of Mrs. Olive Fuller of Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, Loretta Fuller is a graduate of the Kinman Business School and Eastern Washington College.

As the Republican Party's representative in the Sergeant-at-Arms Office, Miss Fuller will assist in providing those service which are essential to the day-to-day operation of the Senate. The Office of the Sergeant-at-Arms has under its jurisdiction the Senate Computer Center, the Senate Doorkeepers, Custodial Services, Capitol Guides, Photographic Studio, Capitol Police, Recording Studio, Service Department and Office of Telecommunications.

"Loretta Fuller is an experienced Hill hand who has the managerial skills and institutional background to make a significant contribution in the Sergeant-at-Arms office. I'm honored to have her representing the Republicans in that slot," Dole said.
