DOLE ANNOUNCES GRANTS FOR KANSAS COLLEGES

Washington D.C. -- Senator Bob Dole (R-KS) today announced that seven Kansas colleges have been awarded Title III grants totalling nearly \$2 million by the U.S. Department of Education.

"I am pleased that so many Kansas colleges are benefiting from the Title III program," said Dole. "These funds will be put to good use for some very worthwhile programs."

The goal of the Title III Strengthening Institutions Program is to improve academic quality while encouraging self-sufficiency. Title III grants are awarded by the U.S. Department of Education under the Higher Education Act of 1965.
