STATEMENT OF SENATOR BOB DOLE SHULTZ ANNOUNCEMENT IN MOSCOW OCTOBER 23, 1987

INF ISSUE

I WELCOME TODAY'S ANNOUNCEMENT IN MOSCOW ON APPARENT PROGRESS TOWARD FINAL ACHIEVEMENT OF AN INF AGREEMENT. A GOOD AGREEMENT WOULD BE AN IMPORTANT STEP FORWARD ON THE ROAD TOWARD A MORE STABLE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES AND THE SOVIET UNION. IT IS ALSO MORE PROOF THAT PRESIDENT REAGAN'S STRATEGY -- OF STRENGTH; BARGAINING TOUGHNESS; FLEXIBILITY; AND CLOSE COOPERATION WITH OUR ALLIES -- THAT STRATEGY WORKS.

SO WHEN THAT TREATY COMES TO THE SENATE, WE'LL BE TAKING A CLOSE LOOK AT IT. I'VE ALREADY MENTIONED A COUPLE OF PARTICULAR AREAS OF CONCERN -- VERIFICATION; MAKING SURE WE HAVE EFFECTIVE OPTIONS TO DEAL WITH SOVIET VIOLATIONS, IF THEY SHOULD OCCUR. AND THERE WILL BE OTHERS.

AND, AS I HAVE ALSO SAID, I'M GOING TO RESERVE FINAL JUDGEMENT UNTIL I SEE THE TREATY; AND UNTIL WE IN THE SENATE HAVE THE CHANCE TO FULFILL OUR CONSTITUTIONAL OBLIGATION TO MAKE AN INFORMED, INDEPENDENT JUDGMENT ON IT.

NO SUMMIT NOW

AS TO THE OTHER HALF OF THE MOSCOW ANNOUNCEMENT: THE FACT THAT THE WIDELY EXPECTED SUMMIT HAS NOT MATERIALIZED REMINDS US AGAIN THAT -- IN LOOKING AT U.S.-SOVIET RELATIONS -- WE JUST HAVE TO KEEP THOSE ROSE-COLORED GLASSES ON THE SHELF.

THE BUZZWORD THESE DAYS IS "GLASNOST," WHICH IS SUPPOSED TO

BE SOMETHING VERY NEW.

BUT I WONDER IF WE'RE NOT SEEING A SOVIET TACTIC THAT IS VERY OLD -- THE SAME TACTIC WE SAW AT REYKJAVIK: YOU DANGLE SOMETHING THAT'S SUPPOSED TO BE A BIG PRIZE -- IN THIS CASE, A SUMMIT; YOU LET EXPECTATIONS BUILD; AND AT THE LAST MINUTE YOU THROW A NEW DEMAND ON THE TABLE. THIS TIME THE GOAL IS CLEARLY TO GET SOME CONCESSIONS ON ABM AND SDI.

WELL, I WOULD WELCOME A SUMMIT. IT COULD BE USEFUL. WE HAVE MANY THINGS TO TALK TO GORBACHEV ABOUT -- ARMS CONTROL, OF COURSE; BUT MANY OTHER THINGS, TOO.

BUT A SUMMIT IS NOT A PRIZE THAT WE SHOULD BE PAYING FOR --ESPECIALLY NOT WITH CONCESSIONS ON SOMETHING AS IMPORTANT AS SDI OR THE ABM ISSUE. A SUMMIT IS A PLACE TO DO BUSINESS; AND IF GORBACHEV WOULD RATHER POSTURE THAN DO BUSINESS -- SO BE IT.

SO MY VIEW IS: LET'S GO FORWARD ON THE INF PROCESS. LET'S KEEP THE CHANNELS OF COMMUNICATION OPEN -- ON OTHER ARMS CONTROL ISSUES, AND OTHER THINGS, TOO: REGIONAL CONFLICTS, HUMAN RIGHTS AND ALL THE REST.

AND LET'S JUST RELAX ON THE SUMMIT ISSUE.
