DOLE SUPPORTS KASSEBAUM CALL TO SUSPEND FT. RILEY EXPANSION ACTIVITIES PENDING ANSWERS TO CRITICAL G.A.O. REPORT

WASHINGTON -- SENATE REPUBLICAN LEADER BOB DOLE (R-KANSAS) TODAY JOINED SENATE COLLEAGUE NANCY KASSEBAUM IN CALLING FOR A DELAY OF EXPANSION ACTIVITIES AT FORT RILEY.
