DOLE SELECTS 50 FOR ACADEMY NOMINATIONS

Washington, D.C. -- Kansas Senator Bob Dole has selected 50 young Kansans as 1989 nominees to compete for appointments to the United States Air Force Academy, Merchant Marine Academy, Military Academy, and Naval Academy.

"These young men and women have demonstrated superior academic preparation and leadership qualities along with their strong desire to serve in our nation's armed forces. Kansas can be proud of this impressive group," said Dole.

In addition to the nominees named by Senator Dole, approximately eight other highly qualified candidates from Kansas have received earlier nominations and appointments through other sources. To avoid unnecessary duplication, those individuals were not included on Senator Dole's list.

Using the competitive method of nomination, Senator Dole selects a slate of ten individuals for each vacancy he intends to fill. As the final step in the process, each academy then evaluates the candidates and offers an appointment.

The nomination process begins in the fall, usually during the senior year of high school. At that time, those interested should contact Sentor Dole and each academy admissions office for application materials. The deadline for submitting the completed forms is early December.
