DROUGHT TOUR SCHEDULE IN KANSAS

Washington, D.C. -- Touring drought affected areas in Kansas this Friday, April 14, will be U.S. Secretary of Agriculture Clayton Yeutter, Governor Mike Hayden, Senator Bob Dole, Senator Nancy Kassebaum, Congressman Pat Roberts and Kansas Secretary of Agriculture Sam Brownback. The following is the schedule:

- 11:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Tour Darwin and Alberta McCall's farm, 3445 North Niles Road, New Cambria, Kansas. Take exit #260 off I-70, and go south 1/4 mile. The farm is on the east side of the road.
- 2:30 p.m. - 3:15 p.m. Tour Dale and Lois Rogers' farm. The field to be toured is located one mile west of Glade on Highway 9, on the north side of the highway. It is 1/2 mile west and four miles south of the airport.
- 4:25 p.m. - 5:10 p.m. Tour Jerry and Peggy Barton's farm. Route 1, Colby. The farm is located two miles south of I-70 on Highway 25. The field is on the east side of the road and the home is on the west.
