DOLE, KASSEBAUM TO HOST SOVIET DELEGATION IN KANSAS; DODGE CITY, WICHITA AND HUTCHINSON TO BE VISITED; LEADERS OF SOVIET PARLIAMENT ARRIVE ON OCTOBER 29TH. ***PRESS AVAILABILITIES SUNDAY & MONDAY***

WASHINGTON -- A HIGH-RANKING DELEGATION OF SOVIET LAWMAKERS WILL SOON BE TOURING KANSAS FOR TWO DAYS AS GUESTS OF SENATORS BOB DOLE AND NANCY KASSEBAUM. THE VISIT BEGINS ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 29 WITH STOPS PLANNED IN DODGE CITY, WICHITA AND HUTCHINSON.

THE GROUP WAS INVITED TO THE UNITED STATES BY THE LEADERS OF THE U.S. SENATE, SENATE REPUBLICAN LEADER BOB DOLE OF KANSAS AND SENATE MAJORITY LEADER GEORGE MITCHELL OF MAINE. THE VISIT WAS SANCTIONED BY A SENATE RESOLUTION UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED ON OCTOBER 14.

THE 10-MEMBER DELEGATION REPRESENTING THE SUPREME SOVIET OF THE UNION OF SOVIET SOCIALIST REPUBLICS IS HEADED BY YEVGENIY M. PRIMAKOV, CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL OF UNION OF THE USSR. AS CHAIRMAN OF THE SOVIET COUNCIL OF UNION, HE IS BASICALLY EQUIVALENT TO OUR SPEAKER OF THE U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES. OTHER DELEGATES HOLD POSITIONS THAT CAN BE EQUATED WITH PARTY LEADERSHIP POSITIONS OR COMMITTEE CHAIRMANSHIPS IN THE U.S. CONGRESS.

FOLLOWING A THREE-DAY VISIT IN WASHINGTON, D.C., THE DELEGATION WILL TRAVEL TO BANGOR AND PORTLAND, MAINE; KANSAS; LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA; PITTSBURGH, PENNSYLVANIA; AND NEW YORK, N.Y.

MR. PRIMAKOV IS ONE OF THE KREMLIN'S RISING STARS. HE IS A TOP FOREIGN AFFAIRS ADVISOR TO MIKHAIL GORBACHEV, AND ALSO SERVES AS AN OFFICIAL COMMENTATOR ON BOTH FOREIGN AND DOMESTIC ISSUES. HE PLAYED A KEY ROLE FOR THE SOVIETS IN ALL FOUR REAGAN-GORBACHEV SUMMIT MEETINGS.

"OUR SOVIET GUESTS WILL SOON BE SEEING THE HEARTLAND OF AMERICA, UP CLOSE AND PERSONAL, AND THERE IS NO DOUBT THEY WILL BE IMPRESSED BY WHAT THEY SEE," DOLE SAID. "ABOVE ALL, THEY WILL TAKE BACK TO THE SOVIET UNION A LASTING IMPRESSION OF THE GOOD WILL OF THE PEOPLE OF KANSAS."

"THE FACT THAT THIS DELEGATION IS HERE -- SOME OF THE TOP PEOPLE FROM THEIR PARLIAMENT, JUST WHEN THAT PARLIAMENT IS STARTING TO VOICE THE REAL FEELINGS OF THE SOVIET PEOPLE -- IT'S 'GLASNOST' IN ACTION," DOLE SAID.

"WE'RE GOING TO BE TALKING ABOUT DEFENSE AND ARMS CONTROL, A LOT OF THE THINGS THAT STILL WORRY US LIKE HUMAN RIGHTS AND SOVIET POLICIES AROUND THE WORLD, AND I'M GOING TO BE PUTTING A LOT OF EMPHASIS ON EXPANDING OUR FARM EXPORTS TO THE SOVIET UNION. IT WILL BE A FULL AGENDA, AND I THINK WE'LL GET SOME BUSINESS DONE," DOLE ADDED.
