SOVIET AMBASSADOR TO JOIN SUPREME SOVIET DELEGATION IN KANSAS WESTERN KANSAS TOWN MEETING OPEN TO ALL COMERS SOVIET LAWMAKERS TO SEE DODGE CITY, AIR BASE, GRAIN ELEVATORS

WASHINGTON -- A full slate of Kansas dignitaries will be at McConnell Air Force Base in Wichita Sunday at 11:30 a.m. when a top-level delegation from the Supreme Soviet arrives for a two-day stay in Kansas, accompanied by Ambassador and Mrs. Yuri Dubinin, Soviet Ambassador to the United States. After a short stay at the base four aircraft carrying the visiting delegation and others will depart for Dodge City and a western Kansas Town Meeting at the Dodge City Civic Center.

The 10-member delegation, led by the Yevgeniy M. Primakov, Chairman of the Council of Union of the USSR, will be greeted by Governor Mike Hayden, Senators Bob Dole and Nancy Kassebaum, U.S. Ambassador to The Netherlands C. Howard Wilkins, Base Commander Colonel Tony Robertson, Wichita Mayor Bob Knight and Larry Fleming of the Wichita Chamber of Commerce.

"This visit puts Kansas in the international spotlight and affords a unique opportunity for the people of Kansas and the people of The Soviet Union to meet face to face, trade ideas and trade smiles," Dole said. The delegation, accompanied by almost 20 support personnel from the USSR, is traveling the USA as the guests of Senate Majority Leader George Mitchell (D-Maine) and Senator Dole, the Senate Republican Leader.

The highlight of the trip will be a Western Kansas Town
Meeting at the Dodge City Civic Center, Sunday, October 29th,
beginning at 2:30 p.m. Doors open at 1:30 p.m. "I'm encouraging
people from across western Kansas and across the state to attend
this meeting and trade ideas and experiences with our Soviet
guests," Dole said. "We want a big crowd, and a big Kansas
welcome."

Before attending the Town Meeting the delegation will visit "Old" $\frac{\text{Dodge City}}{\text{p.m.}}$ and tour Boot Hill and the Long Branch Saloon (1:25 $\frac{\text{p.m.}}{\text{p.m.}}$). The ten Soviet delegates and Ambassador Dubinin will be made honorary deputy marshals. At 1:45 p.m. they will proceed to Boot Hill Museum and a briefing on hard red winter wheat and how it came to Kansas from Russia.

Following the town meeting the City of <u>Dodge City</u> will made presentations to Ambassador Dubinin and the <u>delegation</u>, which then flies back to <u>Wichita</u> and a 7:00 p.m. dinner at the Olive Tree Restaurant hosted by Senator Dole, Governor Hayden, Mayor Knight and the Wichita Chamber of Commerce.
