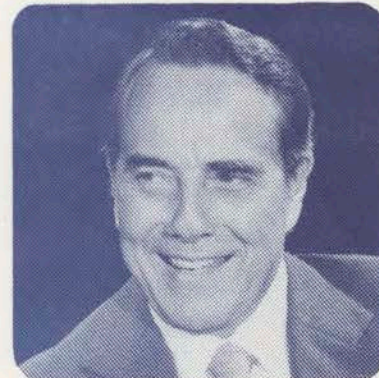

## DOLE MAKES IT OFFICIAL: NO BASE CLOSINGS FOR KANSAS

THERE HAVE BEEN PLENTY OF RUMORS AND LOTS OF ANXIETY LATELY ABOUT BASE CLOSINGS. I KNOW HOW IMPORTANT OUR BASES ARE TO KANSAS, SO LET ME MAKE THE OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENT:

THIS OFFICE HAS PERSONALLY REVIEWED THE PENTAGON'S BASE CLOSING LIST, AND I CAN TELL THE PEOPLE OF KANSAS THAT THERE WILL BE NO CLOSINGS OR REALIGNMENTS IN OUR STATE.

THAT MEANS IT WILL BE BUSINESS AS USUAL FOR FORT RILEY, McCONNELL AIR FORCE BASE, AND FORT LEAVENWORTH -- AND THAT ADDS UP TO GREAT NEWS FOR KANSAS.

### WE DIDN'T LUCK OUT

NOW, THIS DOESN'T MEAN WE LUCKED OUT, THAT WE ARE SOMEHOW SAVING OBSOLETE, NON-ESSENTIAL MILITARY FACILITIES. JUST THE OPPOSITE: TODAY'S GOOD NEWS TELLS US THAT OUR KANSAS BASES ARE FRONTLINE, HIGH-TECH COMPONENTS OF THE WORLD'S FINEST FIGHTING FORCE -- AND THEY HAVE EARNED THAT KIND OF RECOGNITION, AT HOME AND ON THE BATTLEFIELD.

NO DOUBT ABOUT IT, OPERATION DESERT STORM PROVED JUST HOW IMPORTANT KANSAS IS WHEN THE BIG RED ONE, AND MEN AND WOMEN FROM EVERY BASE AND GUARD UNIT IN OUR STATE HELPED WIN THE WAR IN THE GULF.
