## LIBERAL AIRPORT TO RECEIVE \$504,000 FOR IMPROVEMENTS

WASHINGTON - SENATOR BOB DOLE (R-KS) ANNOUNCED FEDERAL FUNDING OF \$504,000 FOR THE LIBERAL AIRPORT TO MAKE NEEDED IMPROVEMENTS TO THE FACILITY. THE FUNDING, FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, COMES FROM THE AVIATION TRUST FUND AND IS MADE SOLELY AT THE DISCRETION OF THE SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION, SAMUEL SKINNER.

THE MONEY WILL BE USED TO OVERLAY THE NORTH APRON, INSTALL VISUAL APPROACH AIDS ON RUNWAY 21 AND INSTALL DISTANCE MARKERS.
