DOLE BRINGS MADIGAN TO FAIR

DOLE BRINGING AG SECRETARY MADIGAN TO KANSAS STATE FAIR
SEPTEMBER 14, 1991

WASHINGTON -- KANSAS SENATOR BOB DOLE ANNOUNCED TODAY THAT U.S. SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE ED MADIGAN HAS ACCEPTED THE SENATOR'S INVITATION TO JOIN HIM AT THE KANSAS STATE FAIR ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 1991.

"I AM DELIGHTED SECRETARY MADIGAN HAS ACCEPTED MY INVITATION TO COME TO THE STATE FAIR. HIS VISIT WILL GIVE KANSAS FARMERS A RARE OPPORTUNITY TO DISCUSS ISSUES FACE-TO-FACE WITH THE NATION'S TOP AG OFFICIAL. I KNOW HE WILL VALUE THE KANSAS INPUT HE'LL GET AT THE FAIR, " DOLE SAID.

SENATOR DOLE SAID HIS OFFICE WOULD PROVIDE FULL DETAILS OF THE TRIP IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

MADIGAN WAS APPOINTED BY PRESIDENT BUSH AS SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE IN MARCH, 1991. BEFORE JOINING BUSH'S CABINET, MADIGAN, BORN IN LINCOLN, ILLINOIS, WAS A MEMBER OF CONGRESS SINCE 1973, SERVING AS THE RANKING REPUBLICAN ON THE HOUSE AGRICULTURE COMMITTEE. PRIOR TO THAT HE WAS A STATE LEGISLATOR FROM 1967-73.
