GINSBURG NOMINATION

Washington -- Senate Republican Leader Bob Dole today made the following remarks on the Senate floor regarding President Clinton's nomination of Judge Ruth Bader Ginsburg to the Supreme Court:

President Clinton made a good choice today with his nomination of Judge Ruth Bader Ginsburg to fill the vacancy on the Supreme Court caused by the expected departure of Justice Byron White.

As a former professor of law and as a member of the highpowered D.C. Court of Appeals, Judge Ginsburg undoubtedly has the experience and the intellect to hit the ground running if confirmed.

Not surprisingly, she has a long paper trail, having written hundreds of legal opinions and more than 40 articles. We will have to review Judge Ginsburg's extensive written record before reaching any final judgments...But I expect her nomination to be well-received in the senate.
