DOLE APPOINTS KANSAN TO LIBRARY OF CONGRESS TRUST FUND BOARD

WASHINGTON - Kansas Senator Bob Dole today announced the appointment of Adele Hall of Shawnee Mission to the Library of Congress Trust Fund Board.

Mrs. Hall will serve a two-year term as one of ten citizen appointees to the Trust Fund Board charged with overseeing gifts to the Library and advising the Library on investments. Statutory members of the Board include the Secretary of the Treasury, the Chairman of the Joint Committee on the Library and the Librarian of the Congress.

"Adele is well-known and respected in the greater Kansas City area," said Dole. "She'll bring a world of experience and Midwestern common sense to the task of managing public trust in one of America's most valued educational resources."

Mrs. Hall sits on the Executive Committee of the United Negro College Fund, and is Chairman of the Board of the Greater Kansas City Community Foundation and the Partnership for Children. She has been honored as Kansas City Philanthropist of the Year, and is the recipient of the Excellence in Governance Award and the National Award for Voluntarism by the National Federation of Business and Professional Women.

Mrs. Hall is a graduate of the University of Nebraska. She and her husband, Don, have three children and six grandchildren.
