SENATE DELIVERS ON DOLE'S REQUEST TO EXPAND LENEXA POST OFFICE

Washington -- The U.S. Senate has given final approval to Kansas Senator Bob Dole's request to direct the U.S. Postal Service to expand the Post Office in Lenexa, Kansas.

"This proposal should help the Postal Service deliver on its plans to expand the Lenexa Post Office," Dole said. "This legislation encourages the Postal Service, using available funds, to work with the residents of Lenexa on a long-term plan to expand the city's postal facility and provide additional parking on adjacent property in a timely fashion. No doubt about it, as the Kansas City, Kansas area continues to grow, important services need to grow, as well."

Senator Dole's proposal is included in the 1994 Treasury/Postal spending bill, approved late Thursday night, which now goes to the President for his signature.
