DOLE ANNOUNCES RETURN OF MOBILE CONSTITUENT SERVICE
TO SOUTHEAST KANSAS

WASHINGTON -- Senator Bob Dole's Southeast Kansas Office is hitting the road. In an effort to better serve the people of Southeast Kansas, Senator Dole is replacing his Pittsburg office with a mobile office which will enable Senator Dole's constituent service staff to reach into every corner of Southeast Kansas.

"I'm pleased to restore a mobile constituent service office to Southeast Kansas," Senator Dole said. "We're always looking for better ways to serve the people of Kansas, and this efficient office-on-wheels will make it easier for more Kansans to get the personal service they sometimes need to help resolve problems with the federal government or to help cut red tape."

The Dole mobile office will be staffed by Jill Maycumber, who has been the Senator's regional representative in the Pittsburg office for the past year.
