Emporia Company Wins Contract

WASHINGTON - Professional Printing of Kansas, Inc., based in Emporia, was awarded a \$1.3 million contract by the Government Printing Office (GPO). Under the two-year agreement, Professional Printing, Inc. will supply the Justice Department with 94 million fingerprint cards.

"No doubt about it, Professional Printing is a Kansas success story," said Senator Bob Dole. "In 1993, it was named the Kansas Small Business of the Year by the Small Business Administration. Now it has scored an impressive win over four other bidders across the nation."
