DOLE NAMES ALAN COBB AND SCOTT HESSE AS DEPUTY STATE DIRECTORS

WASHINGTON - Kansas Senator Bob Dole has named Alan Cobb and Scott Hesse as Deputy State Directors. Cobb, an attorney in Wichita, will oversee the Senator's Kansas City office. Hesse, a Manhattan attorney, will oversee the Senator's Topeka office. Both will focus on constituent service.
