STRIKER REPLACEMENT

INAPPROPRIATE FOR PRESIDENT TO END RUN CONGRESS:
DOLE TO SUPPORT LEGISLATION OPPOSING MISGUIDED DIRECTIVE

WASHINGTON -- Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole today issued the following statement regarding President Clinton's executive order on the hiring of permanent replacement workers:

"Today's Executive Order on striker replacement sets a dangerous precedent. It is the responsibility of Congress, not the Administration, to write the laws governing labor-management relations in this country.

"Congress has repeatedly rejected the striker replacement bill. It is inappropriate for the President to end run Congress by reviving this defeated legislation through an Executive Order.

"I intend to join with my colleague from Kansas, Senator Kassebaum, in advancing legislation that will prevent enforcement of this misguided Presidential directive."
