JOHN SCHALL JOINS STAFF OF MAJORITY LEADER DOLE

WASHINGTON -- Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole has announced that John A. Schall has joined his staff as Assistant to the Republican Leader. Schall, of Ann Arbor, Michigan, will have responsibility for federal budget issues.

Schall narrowly lost a campaign for the U.S. Congress in Michigan's 13th District last November. He previously served as Chief of Staff of the U.S. Department of Labor from 1991 to 1993, and served in the White House under President George Bush as deputy of the White House Domestic Policy Council from 1989 to 1991. Prior to his Domestic Policy Council service, he was Legislative Director for U.S. Representative Connie Mack, a staff member of the House Budget Committee, and a staff member at the White House Office of Management and Budget.

Schall is a 1982 graduate of the University of Michigan, and holds a Masters of Public Policy degree from Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government.
