Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole, Representative Charles Canady (R-FL), other members of the Senate and House, as well as outside representatives, will hold a news conference Thursday to announce introduction of "The Equal Opportunity Act of 1995."

The legislation is designed to restore to federal law the principles of nondiscrimination and equal opportunity, and would prohibit the use of racial and gender preferences by the federal government in federal procurement, federal employment, and the administration of federally-conducted programs.

The news conference will be held at 2:00 PM on Thursday, July 27, in room S-207 of the U.S. Capitol.
