FORT LEAVENWORTH PROJECT WINS FINAL SENATE APPROVAL

WASHINGTON - Kansas Senator Bob Dole announced today that the U.S. Senate gave final approval to \$4.4 million for Phase II construction of a Corps Simulation Center at Fort Leavenworth.

"Leavenworth has one of the foremost battle simulation training centers in the nation," Dole said. "In my view, investing in the Leader Development Center will yield vital improvements in readiness, and help ensure Leavenworth's reputation as a leader in this field."

The project, which is part of the Pentagon's Future Years Defense Program, was included in the \$11.17 billion 1996 Military Construction Appropriations Bill. The bill now heads to the President's desk to be signed into law.
