STATEMENT OF SENATE MAJORITY LEADER BOB DOLE

WASHINGTON -- Senate Majority Leader Bob Dole today issued the following statement regarding the Clinton Administration's announcement that it has granted Cuban dictator Fidel Castro's request for a visa permitting him to address the United Nations:

"It is regrettable that President Clinton did not exercise his authority to deny a visa for Fidel Castro. I wish the Clinton Administration would spend more time supporting democratic change in Cuba and less time honoring the requests of this hemisphere's last remaining dictator."
