

Congressman Dole's Introduction of Senator Goldwater
in Madison Square Garden, New York City -- Tuesday,
May 12, 1964

Thank you very much, ladies and gentlemen. The moment is about here. We are here tonight to rally around the man who will again make the White House the "Light House." We need the light seriously--the light of leadership, of integrity, and of dedication to this nation, its people and its Constitution. For 11 years the man we honor tonight has illuminated the Washington scene. In the Senate he stands squarely with his party on the great majority of issues and squarely with his conscience on every issue. What kind of a Republican is he? He is this kind--the kind that every American can trust to keep his freedom and liberty. He's a Major General in the Air Force Reserve who has shattered the sound barrier and qualified to fly everything from a jet airliner to the fastest fighter; an electronics expert, which will help in the White House; a keen student of natural history; a political scientist whose thinking has had a profound effect on this country; and a leading authority on the Indian culture of his native Southwest. He is, to put it another way, a kind of a man who might carry around in the glove compartment of his sports car a copy of the Constitution. He is the best of the past and, more important, the best hope for the future. To me, from the Midwest, his candidacy has a special meaning, for we have long looked forward to the day when our Republican Party would outgrow all of its sectional differences and truly become a fully and truly national party. Today it has that opportunity. It has a leader who speaks for the entire nation and the entire party, who has worked across this nation for the entire party and the entire nation, who has voted with his party, who has supported its principles and who has never sought to weaken or divide the Republican Party. He has sought to build and unite. We have a leader whose voice is clear in the West, the South, the East and the North. The
