

Remarks of Congressman Bob Dole



AGRICULTURE AND ITS RELATION TO U. S. FOREIGN POLICY

I AM PLEASED TO HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO PARTICIPATE IN YOUR SUMMER PLANNING CONFERENCE. MR. BLANKENHAGEN HAS GIVEN ME ONE SPECIFIC TOPIC AND A NUMBER OF OTHER TOPICS, INCLUDING PUBLIC LAW 480, THE "FARMER-TO-FARMER" PROGRAM,
THE KENNEDY ROUND OF GATT, AND THE IMPORTANCE OF AGRICULTURE TO OUR NATIONAL
ECONOMY. AS A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE AND THE SUBCOMMITTEE
ON FOREIGN AGRICULTURAL OPERATIONS, I CAN STATE THAT THERE IS A GROWING AWARENESS BY THE AMERICAN PEOPLE OF THE IMPENDING WORLD FOOD AND POPULATION CRISIS.
IN MY OPINION, "FOOD AID" WILL BECOME OUR MOST IMPORTANT FOREIGN POLICY INSTRU-

LAST FALL, AT THE REQUEST OF THE PRESIDENT, I VISITED INDIA IN AN EFFORT TO DETERMINE THE SCOPE OF FOOD NEEDS THERE, AND THERE IS A STRONG POSSIBILITY THAT MEMBERS OF OUR FOREIGN AGRICULTURAL OPERATIONS SUBCOMMITTEE, MYSELF
INCLUDED, WILL BE VISITING ISRAEL AND OTHER MID-EAST COUNTRIES WITHIN THE NEXT
FEW WEEKS IN AN EFFORT TO DETERMINE THE SCOPE OF THE FOOD CRISIS IN THAT AREA.
THIS IN ITSELF INDICATES THE TREMENDOUS ROLE FOOD AID, OR POTENTIAL AMERICAN
FOOD AID, PLAYS IN OUR FOREIGN POLICY DECISIONS.

LET US TAKE A LOOK THEN AT A FEW BASIC POPULATION FACTS THAT DEFY EVEN OUR MOST CASUAL TEMPTATION TO IGNORE.

THE WORLD'S POPULATION, ACCORDING TO MANY EXPERTS, IS GROWING FASTER
THAN ITS ABILITY TO PRODUCE FOOD. IN THE PERIOD OF TIME FROM TODAY TO THE
END OF THE 20TH CENTURY, THERE WILL BE MORE PEOPLE ADDED TO THE WORLD'S
POPULATION ROSTER THAN ARE ALIVE TODAY. IN A FEW YEARS, OVER HALF THE
