THIS IS MY THIRD VISIT TO BROWN COUNTY SINCE ANNOUNCING
MY CANDIDACY FOR THE U.S. SENATE, AND YOU MAY BE ASSURED I
WILL BE BACK -- AGAIN--AND AGAIN--AND AGAIN.

THIS BEING A REPUBLICAN MEETING, I WANT TO SPEAK TO YOU BRIEFLY ABOUT ONE THING: THE REPUBLICAN OPPORTUNITY IN NOVEMBER 1968.

ON THE NATIONAL LEVEL, REPUBLICANS HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY

TO CAPTURE THE WHITE HOUSE, GAIN CONTROL OF THE HOUSE OF REP
RESENTATIVES AND PICK UP SEVERAL SEATS IN THE U.S. SENATE.

I SAY WE HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY BECAUSE OF FOUR PRIMARY
ASSETS OF THE REPUBLICAN PARTY: THE CANDIDATES, THE PHILOSOPHY,
THE TIDE OF PUBLIC OPINION AND THE ISSUES.

-THE CANDIDATES-

FIRST, WE'VE GOT THE PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES -RICHARD NIXON AND NELSON ROCKEFELLER -- WHO HAVE
PLEDGED THEMSELVES NOT TO SLIP, DUCK OR HIDE FROM THE
ISSUES, BUT TO MEET THE ISSUES HEAD ON WITH POSITIVE,
RESPONSIBLE STATEMENTS AND ACTION.

EVEN A CURSORY GLANCE AT NEWSPAPERS, NATIONAL

NEWS MAGAZINES OR TELEVISION SHOWS THESE TWO MEN ARE

READY TO MOVE WITH HUMILITY AND ENERGY . . . TO TURN

AMERICA'S GAZE IN NEW DIRECTIONS . . . TO GUIDE THIS

COUNTRY'S VAST RESOURCES . . . AND UPLIFT ITS PEOPLE TO

WORK TO HOUSE, TO EDUCATE, TO BUILD, TO CREATE AND INSPIRE.

-THE PHILOSOPHY-

SECOND, THE G.O.P. PHILOSOPHY HOLDS OUT HOPE AND PROMISES ACTION. REPUBLICANS KNOW -- AND FOR THAT MATTER, MOST AMERICANS KNOW -- THAT THE DEMOCRATIC PHILOSOPHY OF FEDERAL SOLUTIONS, FEDERALLY-FINANCED AND FEDERALLY-ADMINISTERED HAS NOT WORKED IN EIGHT YEARS AND WILL NOT WORK NOW OR IN THE FUTURE.

REPUBLICANS KNOW THAT THE GOVERNMENT MUST SUPPORT

THE EFFORTS OF BUSINESS, INDUSTRY, OTHER GROUPS AND

INDIVIDUALS -- BUT THAT GOVERNMENT ALONE CANNOT WAGE THE

WARS OR WIN THE PEACE -- AT HOME OR ABROAD.

REPUBLICANS CAN PROVIDE THE IMAGINATIVE, NEW LEADERSHIP
THAT CAN INSPIRE OTHERS. REPUBLICANS UNDERSTAND AND BELIEVE
IN PEOPLE. THEY VIEW THEIR FELLOW AMERICANS AS <u>INDIVIDUALS</u> -NOT AS MEMBERS OF VOTING BLOCS TO BE MOVED ABOUT LIKE
PAWNS: IN A POLITICAL CHESS GAME.

-PUBLIC OPINION-

THIRD, THE TIDE OF PUBLIC OPINION. REPUBLICANS HAVE

A BUILT-IN NATIONAL AUDIENCE. IF EVER AMERICANS WERE READY

FOR NEW LEADERSHIP, THEY ARE READY THIS YEAR.

EIGHT YEARS OF DEMOCRATED CONTROL HAVE NOT ESCAPED
THE PUBLIC EYE. THE RECORD HAS BEEN, AND IS, OPEN FOR
ALL TO JUDGE.

THE REPUBLICAN PARTY -- WITH THE HELP OF MANY INDEPENDENTS AND DISENCHANTED DEMOCRATS -- CAN MAKE SWEEPING
GAINS IN THE NOVEMBER ELECTIONS. AND THE PUBLIC UTTERANCES
OF DEMOCRAT HUBERT HUMPHREY, DEMOCRAT EUGENE MCCARTHY AND
DEMOCRAT ROBERT KENNEDY WILL HELP INCREASE THE SCOPE OF
THE REPUBLICAN WINS.

-THE 1968 ISSUES-

TO THESE THREE G.O.P. ASSETS -- CANDIDATES, PHILOSOPHY

AND PUBLIC OPINION -- ADD ISSUES FOR THE REPUBLICAN OP
PORTUNITY IN 1968 UNDOUBTEDLY HAS THE ISSUES.

A NEWS REPORTER RECENTLY SAID PRESIDENT JOHNSON'S DECISION NOT TO RUN AND THE RESULTING FLURRY OF DEMOCRATIC PRESIDENTIAL HOPEFULS HAVE NEUTRALIZED THE ISSUES REPUBLICANS HAVE BEEN CONCENTRATING ON.

THIS IS NOT TRUE. THE MAJOR PROBLEMS CONFRONTING
THIS NATION HAVE NOT BEEN SOLVED. THE RECORD IS PLAIN.

- ** DESPITE THE PARIS PEACE TALKS,
 PEACE DOES NOT REIGN IN VIETNAM.
 WE ARE STILL ENGAGED IN A MAJOR
 WAR WHICH IS COSTING US DEARLY -IN LIVES, IN DOLLARS, IN UNITY
 AT HOME, IN PRESTIGE ABROAD.
- ** THE NATION'S LARGEST CITIES HAVE SUFFERED SOME OF THE WORST CIVIL DISTURBANCES IN OUR HISTORY AND ARE BRACING THEMSELVES FOR MORE THIS SUMMER.
- ** THE NATIONAL CRIME RATE SOARS -EVEN AFTER JUMPING 83 PER CENT FROM
 1960 TO 1967, WHEN THE POPULATION
 INCREASED 11 PER CENT.
- ** THE DOLLAR IS IN CRITICAL CONDITION

 -- WE HAVE AN ALL-TIME HIGH COST OF
 LIVING . . THE DEFICIT IN OUR
 BALANCE OF PAYMENTS IS DEEP. OUR
 SUPPLY OF GOLD IS ABYSMALLY LOW; THE
 NUMBER OF DOLLARS HELD BY FOREIGNERS,
 DANGEROUSLY HIGH.
- ** AMERICAN FARMERS, THE MOST EFFICIENT AND EFFECTIVE IN THE WORLD, SUFFERED AN INCOME LOSS OF 1.9 BILLION DOLLARS LAST YEAR.
- ** WE HAVE A SPRAWLING FEDERAL GOVERNMENT WHICH MANY PEOPLE NEITHER UNDERSTAND NOR BELIEVE.

LET'S LOOK CLOSER AT A FEW OF THE ISSUES.

-FISCAL AND MONETARY MATTERS-

FIRST, IN THE FIELD OF FISCAL AND MONETARY MATTERS.

THE DEMOCRATS ARE BRAGGING ABOUT MORE THAN 80 MONTHS

OF "UNINTERRUPTED PROSPERITY".

BUT THE U.S. LABOR DEPARTMENT SAYS FLATLY THE WAGE GAINS AMERICAN WORKERS MADE IN 1966 AND 1967 WERE WIPED OUT BY INCREASES IN THE COST OF LIVING.

THE NAME OF THE GAME IS INFLATION, NOT PROSPERITY.

INFLATION -- HIGH PRICES-- HURTS EVERYONE, BUT ESPECIALLY THE VERY PEOPLE WE MOST NEED TO HELP . . . THE
POOR . . . THE SICK . . . THE RETIRED . . . THE WIDOWED.

INFLATION HAS HURT THE FARMER. ALTHOUGH HIS INCOME WENT UP A LITTLE IN THE LAST SEVEN YEARS, THE INDEX OF PRICES HE PAID WENT UP 44 POINTS.

INFLATION HAS JACKED UP INTEREST RATES AND CREATED SPECIAL PROBLEMS FOR HOME BUYERS AND ALL AMERICANS WHO FIND IT NECESSARY TO BORROW.

INFLATION HAS HURT OUR FOREIGN TRADE TO THE POINT
WHERE OUR TRADE SURPLUS HAS FALLEN TO AN ANNUAL RATE OF
LESS THAN 2 BILLION DOLLARS. OUR BALANCE OF TRADE ACTUALLY
SLIPPED INTO DEFICIT DURING MARCH, THE FIRST TIME SINCE
1963.

THEN THERE IS THE GOLD CRISIS, THE RESULT OF AN INTERNATIONAL CRISIS OF CONFIDENCE IN THE FISCAL AND MONETARY POLICIES PURSUED BY THE DEMOCRATS.

THERE IS NO DOUBT ABOUT IT: AMERICA IS IN SERIOUS
FINANCIAL STRAITS. FEDERAL RESERVE BOARD CHAIRMAN MARTIN
CALLS IT THE WORST FINANCIAL CRISIS SINCE THE DEPRESSION.

SOME TIME TWO YEARS AFTER THEY ESCALATED THE VIETNAM WAR, THE DEMOCRATS BEGAN TO DISCOVER WHAT THE REPUBLICANS HAD BEEN SAYING FOR YEARS -- THIS COUNTRY CAN'T LIVE BEYOND ITS MEANS.

THE ADMINISTRATION'S ANSWER? TAX THE PEOPLE MORE, OF COURSE.

MANY MONTHS OF HAGGLING BETWEEN THE CONGRESS AND THE ADMINISTRATION ENSUED. IN ESSENCE, THE CONGRESS SAID, A TAX INCREASE MAY, IN FACT, BE NECESSARY, BUT YOU CAN'T COLLECT MORE MONEY FROM THE PEOPLE UNLESS THERE ARE MASSIVE REDUCTIONS IN FEDERAL SPENDING.

THE ADMINISTRATION BALKED.

TODAY, THIS IS THE STATUS OF THE PROPOSAL: HOUSE

AND SENATE CONFEREES HAVE AGREED ON A 10 PERCENT INCOME

TAX SURCHARGE THAT PRESIDENT JOHNSON WANTS AND A 6 BILLION

DOLLAR SPENDING CUT IN THE FEDERAL BUDGET THAT HE DOESN'T

WANT.

NO ONE REALLY WANTS A TAX INCREASE. NO ONE, FOR THAT MATTER, WANTS TO CUT BACK ON POPULAR PROGRAMS, SOME OF WHICH ARE DEMONSTRATING LIMITED EFFECTIVENESS.

BUT THE FACT IS: THE DEMOCRATS HAVE LED US TO A POINT OF NO RETURN UNLESS DRASTIC STEPS ARE TAKEN.

THE GREAT FAILURE OF DEMOCRAT LEADERSHIP HAS BEEN
THEIR REFUSAL TO ESTABLISH SPENDING PRIORITIES AND ECONOMIC
DISCIPLINE. NO MATTER HOW YOU CUT IT, NO FAMILY, NO TOWN,
NO COUNTY, NO STATE, NO NATION CAN HAVE EVERYTHING IT WANTS
AT ONCE.

I URGE YOU TO LISTEN TO THE PUBLIC STATEMENTS OF

DEMOCRAT CANDIDATES HUMPHREY, MCCARTHY, KENNEDY AND WALLACE.

IF YOU HEAR WHAT I HEAR, YOU HEAR PROMISES, EXPENSIVE

PROMISES, PROMISES OF NEW PROGRAMS ON TOP OF OLD PROGRAMS

WITH NO REGARD FOR OUR FISCAL DILEMMA.

YES, ON ITS PAST RECORD AND ON ITS CURRENT PUBLIC STATEMENTS, IT IS DOUBTFUL DEMOCRATS COULD BRING THIS COUNTRY OUT OF ITS FISCAL AND MONETARY CRISIS.

-CIVIL DISORDER-

THE FISCAL AND MONETARY MESS APPEARS TO CLASH HEAD ON WITH THE DESPERATE DEMANDS OF OUR CITIES AND THE GROWING CIVIL DISORDER.

THERE IS NO SIMPLE SOLUTION TO THE CRISIS IN THE CITIES. BUT I CAN TELL YOU THIS: THE DEMOCRAT SOLUTION

-- FEDERAL PROJECTS, FEDERALLY-FINANCED AND FEDERALLYADMINISTERED -- IS NOT IT.

THE WAR ON POVERTY HAS PROVEN THAT BEYOND A SHADOW

OF A DOUBT. BILLIONS OF DOLLARS HAVE BEEN EXPENDED,

MUCH OF IT IN AREAS LIKE DETROIT, WASHINGTON AND NEWARK,

AND STILL THERE ARE RIOTS AND LOOTING AND DEMANDS FOR

MORE FEDERAL AID.

IF 5 OR 10 BILLION DOLLARS HAS NOT MADE AN APPRECIABLE DENT IN POVERTY, THE <u>ULTIMATE</u> ANSWER IS NOT SPENDING 20 OR 50 BILLION DOLLARS BY THE GOVERNMENT.

ONCE AGAIN, OUR PRIORITIES HAVE BEEN MISGUIDED.

OUR FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS IS TO RECOGNIZE NO

AMERICANS-- BLACK OR WHITE -- CAN LIVE TOGETHER DIVIDED

BY HATRED. EVERY INDIVIDUAL MUST REDEDICATE HIMSELF TO

THE TRUTH WHICH THE AUTHORS OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE

SAID IS SELF-EVIDENT -- THAT ALL MEN ARE CREATED EQUAL.

A CHANGE IN ATTITUDE WON'T ELIMINATE SLUMS, BUT IT WILL HELP COOL THE PASSIONS WHICH ERUPT INTO VIOLENCE.

BELIEVING AND LIVING THE FACT THAT ALL MEN ARE CREATED

EQUAL IS A PERSONAL MATTER. IT STARTS WITH YOU. NO LAW

--NO MATTER HOW COMPREHENSIVE OR HOW HERALDED -- WILL AUTO
MATICALLY USHER IN BROTHERLY LOVE. WE CANNOT LEGISLATE

TOGETHERNESS.

WHAT WILL COUNT IS GENUINELY FAIR ACTION ON FALL FRONTS -- ACTION WHICH IGNORES ALL FORMS OF ARBITRARY DISCRIMINATION.

IN MY OPINION AND IN THE OPINION OF MANY REPUBLICANS,
FIRST CALL ON GOVERNMENT FUNDS TO HELP PEOPLE HELP THEMSELVES SHOULD BE FOR EDUCATION.

LARGE SUMS ARE BEING SPENT ON WELFARE PROGRAMS, PRISON SYSTEMS, INSURANCE FOR RIOT DAMAGE. SOME OF THE MONEY COULD BE SAVED -- AND BE BETTER DIRECTED -- IF IT WERE SPENT ON EDUCATION.

ONLY BY WELL EDUCATING ALL OF OUR YOUTH -- PARTICULARLY

DURING THE ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL YEARS -- DO WE

HAVE ANY LASTING HOPE OF TRULY HELPING PEOPLE HELP THEMSELVES.

THE BETTER THE EDUCATION, THE BETTER THE JOBS, THE BETTER THE HOUSING AND SO ON -- IT'S A CHAIN REACTION.

THERE MUST BE A COMMITMENT OF EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES

-- FUNDS, FACILITIES, PERSONNEL AND LEADERSHIP -- THAT MUST

BE SUMMONED AT ALL LEVELS OF GOVERNMENT TO OVERCOME THE

EDUCATIONAL DEFICIT EXISTING IN MANY CITIES.

ANOTHER PRIORITY WE MUST HAVE IS JOBS -- JOBS TO HELP
PEOPLE HELP THEMSELVES AND TO RELIEVE THE MOUNTING PRESSURES
IN THE CITIES.

REPUBLICANS HAVE ALWAYS ENCOURAGED BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY
TO TAKE THE LEAD IN THE JOB FIELD.

BUSINESS CAN REACH OUT TO RECUIT THE HOPELESS IN THE SLUMS WHERE THEY LIVE. BUSINESS CAN RE-THINK PRODUCTION PROCESSES, SO THAT THE JOB CAN BE FITTED TO THE MAN RATHER THAN THE MAN TO THE JOB. BUSINESS CAN GREATLY EXPAND ITS TRAINING AND RETRAINING PROGRAMS.

THERE MUST BE SWEEPING PROGRAMS, TOO, TO CONTROL

CRIME AND JUVENILE DELINQUENCY, IMPROVE LAW ENFORCEMENT,

REVISE OUR COURT SYSTEM AND CRACK DOWN ON ORGANIZED CRIME.

THE DEMOCRATS HAVE FAILED TO MOVE WITH URGENCY TOWARD A

SOLUTION TO THIS PRESSING PROBLEM OF CRIME.
