## REMARKS OF HONORABLE BOB DOLE

INTRODUCTION OF SENATOR BARRY GOLDWATER MISSOURI GOP FUND RAISING DINNER KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI MONDAY, OCTOBER 4, 1971

I AM ESPECIALLY HONORED TONIGHT TO BE GIVEN THE PRIVILEGE OF INTRO-DUCING ONE OF THE GIANTS OF OUR TIME -- A GREAT AMERICAN, A GREAT REPUBLICAN, A MAN WHOM HISTORY HAS ALREADY PROVEN RIGHT.

THIS "PEDDLER'S SON", AS ANOTHER LEGENDARY AMERICAN, SENATOR EVERETT DIRKSEN, CALLED HIM, HAS BECOME IN HIS OWN TIME THE SYMBOL OF WHAT IS RIGHT WITH THE REPUBLICAN PARTY. HE IS A MAN WHO, WITHOUT HESITANCY, IS LOYAL TO HIS PARTY, TO HIS COUNTRY AND TO HIS OWN PRINCIPLES -- AND WHO HAS FOUND ALL OF THESE LOYALTIES TO BE COMPATIBLE WITH EACH OTHER AND WITH AMERICA.
