I AM PLEASED TO BE HERE THIS EVENING AND TO BE TOGETHER WITH SO MANY REPUBLICANS WHO SHARE A COMMON PURPOSE, THE RE-ELECTION OF THE PRESIDENT AND VICTORIES FOR OUR PARTY IN STATE AND LOCAL OFFICES.

WE NEED THOSE VICTORIES.

IT HAS BEEN SAID TO THE POINT OF CLICHE THAT THE VERY

FUTURE OF THE COUNTRY DEPENDS ON THEM. CERTAINLY THE KIND OF

FUTURE WE REPUBLICANS -- AND I THINK MOST AMERICANS -- WANT FOR

THIS COUNTRY DEPENDS ON THE FALL ELECTIONS.

FORWARD TO CONTINUED PROGRESS

WE WANT, AND WE NEED, MORE OF THE GENUINE PROGRESS WE HAVE ENJOYED UNDER THE SOLID REPUBLICAN LEADERSHIP OF RICHARD NIXON.

WE WANT, AND WE NEED, CONTINUED PROGRESS IN THE TRANSITION FROM AN ERA OF CONFRONTATION TO AN ERA OF NEGOTIATION.

WE WANT, AND WE NEED, CONTINUED PROGRESS IN THE TRANSITION FROM A WAR-TIME ECONOMY TO PEACE-TIME PROSPERITY.

WE WANT, AND WE NEED, CONTINUED RESPONSIBLE LEADERSHIP TOWARD GOVERNMENTAL REFORM.

WHAT WE DON'T WANT, AND WHAT WE CERTAINLY DON'T NEED IN
THIS COUNTRY, IS A RETURN TO OUR EXPERIENCE OF THE SIXTIES -- A
RETURN TO DEMOCRAT ADMINISTRATIONS WITH THEIR HIGH-BLOWN PROMISES
THAT CANNOT BE KEPT.

AND I BELIEVE MOST AMERICANS WILL AGREE THAT WHAT WE NEED

MOST OF ALL IS FOUR MORE YEARS OF THE KIND OF INTELLIGENT AND

IMAGINATIVE LEADERSHIP IN THE WHITE HOUSE THAT WE HAVE HAD FOR THE

LAST THREE AND A HALF YEARS.

I KNOW MOST AMERICANS WILL AGREE IF WE DO OUR PART -- IF
WE MAKE THEM FULLY AWARE OF THE RECORD OF THE NIXON ADMINISTRATION.
IT IS A PROUD RECORD. LET'S MAKE SURE THAT IT IS A WELL-KNOWN
RECORD, TOO, AND THAT IT IS AS WELL UNDERSTOOD AS IT DESERVES TO BE.

IT WILL STAND FOR ITSELF, IF THE VOTERS UNDERSTAND IT. IT WILL STAND FOR ITSELF, IF WE MAKE SURE IT IS WELL KNOWN.

THE <u>SALT</u> TALKS, THE JOURNEY FOR PEACE TO PEKING, VIETNAMIZATION,
DRAFT REFORM, POSTAL REFORM, GOVERNMENT REORGANIZATION -- THESE ARE
ALL PROGRAMS AND ACHIEVEMENTS OF AN ADMINISTRATION THAT UNDERSTANDS
THIS COUNTRY'S NEEDS AND THIS COUNTRY'S ROLE IN THE WORLD.

THE DEMOCRATS ARE DOING THEIR BEST TO OUT=PROMISE EACH OTHER.

THE REAL CAUSE FOR CONCERN LIES, HOWEVER, IN THE FACT THAT, IF ONE

OF THEM IS ELECTED, HE MAY ACTUALLY KEEP THOSE PROMISES, BUT NONE

OF THEM HOLDS ANY REAL PROMISE OF THE KIND OF LEADERSHIP CAPACITY

THAT CAN MATCH THE RECORD OF THIS ADMINISTRATION UNDER RICHARD

NIXON. NOT GEORGE Mc GOVERN, NOR ED MUSKIE, WHOM SOME OF YOU MAY

REMEMBER, NOR HUBERT HUMPHREY NOR TED KENNEDY HAVE BEEN ABLE TO OFFER

THE VOTERS OF THIS COUNTRY ANY COMPELLING REASONS WHY THEY OUGHT

TO CONSIDER A CHANGE IN ADMINISTRATIONS.

AND NONE OF THEM CAN. AND NONE OF THEM WILL.

BECAUSE THERE AREN'T ANY.

DEMOCRATS IN DISARRAY

AND THERE IS SOME EVIDENCE, NOW IN THE NEWS, THAT THEY MAY NOT EVEN BE TRYING VERY HARD. IT SEEMS THAT MUCH MORE IMPORTANT TO SOME OF THEM THAN THE FIGHT FOR CONTROL OF THE WHITE HOUSE, IS THE FIGHT FOR CONTROL OF THEIR PARTY.

AND AS THAT FIGHT CONTINUES, I THINK THAT IT BECOMES

INCREASINGLY EVIDENT THAT WE MAY BE WITNESSING THIS YEAR THE FINAL

DISINTEGRATION OF THE DEMOCRAT PARTY AS WE HAVE KNOWN IT DURING THIS

CENTURY.

IT IS AN AXIOM OF AMERICAN POLITICS THAT THIS COUNTRY IS
ESSENTIALLY A TWO-PARTY COUNTRY AND WILL REMAIN SO. OUR HISTORY
DEMONSTRATES THAT. BUT POLITICAL PARTIES HAVE EXPIRED BEFORE IN
THIS COUNTRY AND THE DEMOCRAT PARTY MAY WELL BE ABOUT TO JOIN THE
FEDERALISTS AND THE WHIGS AND NUMEROUS SMALLER PARTIES ON
HISTORY'S DISCARD SHELF.

FOR THERE IS NOTHING MAGICAL ABOUT THE ORIGINS AND

STRENGTHS OF OUR MAJOR POLITICAL PARTIES. THEY ARE CREATED BY THE

PEOPLE TO REPRESENT THEIR INTERESTS WITHIN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE

UNITED STATES AND WITHIN THEIR STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS. AND

THE SAME PEOPLE WHO CREATED A POLITICAL PARTY CAN ABANDON IT WHEN

IT CEASES TO PERFORM THE FUNCTION FOR WHICH THEY CREATED IT -- WHEN

IT CEASES TO REPRESENT THEM.

THUS, IN SPITE OF THE REGISTRATIONFFIGURES WHICH SHOW MOST PEOPLE CONSIDERING THEMSELVES TO BE DEMOCRATS, I BELIEVE THAT MANY NOMINAL DEMOCRATS ARE ABOUT TO ABANDON THEIR ERSTWHILE PARTY IN DROVES.

FRONT RUNNER NOT THE FAVORITE

THE DEMOCRATS HAVE ONLY RECENTLY GOTTEN BACK WHAT THEY LOST
LAST MARCH IN NEW HAMPSHIRE. NOW THEY HAVE A FRONT-RUNNER AGAIN.

GEORGE MC GOVERN IS NOW CLEARLY THE FAVORITE FOR THE NOMINATION IN
JULY. THAT IS TO SAY, HE IS THE CANDIDATE WITH THE MOST DELEGATES

GOING INTO THE CONVENITON. "FAVORITE," ON SECOND THOUGHT, MAY BE THE
WRONG WORD TO USE.

AND MUCH MORE CONCERNED ABOUT INTERNAL PARTY STRUGGLES FOR

POWER THAN THEY DO ABOUT THE CAMPAIGN FOR THE PRESIDENCY.

LET ME CITE SOME EVENTS WHICH LEAD ME TO THAT CONCLUSION.

FIRST, MANY OF THE DELEGATES ALREADY CHOSEN -- AS MANY AS 25 PERCENT OF THEM -- ARE BEING CHALLENGED BEFORE THE DEMOCRAT CREDENTIALS COMMITTEE.

AND, SECONDLY, MANY OF THE DELEGATES ALREADY CHOSEN HAVE PUBLICLY PROCLAIMED THEIR INTENTION TO VOTE FOR A CANDIDATE OTHER THAN THE ONE THEY ARE BOUND TO BY STATE LAW.

THIRD, THE DEMOCRAT PARTY IS FACED THIS YEAR WITH THE POSSIBILITY OF DEFECTIONS NOT TO ONE SPLINTER PARTY, BUT TO TWO.

TED KENNEDY HAS BEEN MAKING STATEMENTS THAT SEEM TO GO BACK
ON HIS EARLIER DENIALS OF INTEREST IN BEING ON THE DEMOCRAT TICKET -AND THEN DENYING THAT HE MEANT IT. AND NOW, IN THEMMORNING'S
WASHINGTON POST, THERE IS A STORY INDICATING THAT THE REPORTER WHO
INTERVIEWED KENNEDY EARLIER IN THE WEEK FEELS THAT KENNEDY MAY HAVE BEEN
PURPOSELY VAGUE, INTENDING TO STIR UP RENEWED SPECULATION ABOUT
AND SUPPORT FOR THE POSSIBILITY OF HIS RUNNING.

ANOTHER REPORT CARRIED IN THE <u>POST</u> INDICATES LABOR IS

PUSHING KENNEDY FURTHER TOWARD DECLARING HIS CANDIDACY. WHAT IT

ALL MEANS THOUGH NOBODY IS SAYING SO, IS "STOP MC GOVERN."

THE DEMOCRAT GOVERNORS, ALMOST ALL OF THEM, ARE REPORTED TO BELIEVE THAT THEIR STATE PARTIES ARE THREATENED IF MC GOVERN IS THE NOMINEE AND THE POLLS SHOW DEMOCRAT LEADERS THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY PREFER ANOTHER CANDIDATE OVER THE MAN NOW TOUTED AS THE FAVORITE. LABOR IS MIXED, SOME DEMOCRAT MEMBERS OF CONGRESS SEE THE MC GOVERN NOMINATION AS A POTENTIAL DISASTER. AND WHAT THEY ALL MEANS THOUGH THEY WON'T SAY IT, IS "STOP MC GOVERN."

AND LAST WEEK, IN A LONG DISSERTATION BEFORE THE NATIONAL PRESS CLUB, SENATOR MUSKIE -- YOU REMEMBER HIM -- REFUSED TO OFFER HIS SUPPORT TO SENATOR MC GOVERN. AT THE TIME, SENATOR MUSKIE CONTROLLED APPROXIMATELY ONE-TENTH OF THE DELEGATES HE NEEDED FOR THE NOMINATION. BUT EVEN WITH THAT SMALL A BASE OF SUPPORT, HE LOOKED AHEAD TO GOING TO THE CONVENTION STILL A CANDIDATE FOR NOMINATION. HE SAID HE WANTED TO ASSURE THAT THE CONVENTION HAD A CHOICE.

AND NOW, JUST A COUPLE OF DAYS AGO, MUSKIE AND HIS SIDEKICK, SENATOR HUGHES, LAUNCHED A RENEWED EFFORT TO GET THE MUSKIE "BLANDWAGON" ROLLING AGAIN. MUSKIE SAYS HE WANTS TO MAKE HIMSELF AVAILABLE AT THE CONVENTION AS A "VIABLE ALTERNATIVE" IN CASE THE CONVENTION SHOULD DEADLOCK. WHAT HE MEANS, THOUGH NEITHER HE NOR SENATOR HUGHES IS SAYING SO, IS SIMPLY "STOP MC GOVERN."

THIS IS NOT A PICTURE OF A BROADLY REPRESENTATIVE POLITICAL PARTY PREPARING TO CONTEST FOR THE PRESIDENCY. IT IS A PICTURE OF A PARTY "CANNIBALIZING ITSELF," WITH A VARIETY OF FFACTIONAL CHIEFTAINS BATTLING TO SEE WHO STAYS OUT OF THE POT.

DEMO TROUBLES RUN DEEP

WHILE MANY OBSERVERS MAY DISCOUNT THESE SYMPTOMS OF
DISINTEGRATION AS "GROWING PAINS" BROUGHT ON BY NEW DELEGATE
SELECTION METHODS IN THE DEMOCRAT PARTY THIS YEAR, I THINK THE
CAUSES ARE MUCH TOO DEEP TO BE DI SMISSED AS "PROCEDURAL." THE
CAUSES ARE A CHANGING ELECTORATE WHICH IS SOPHISTICATED ENOUGH TO

DISCOUNT THE RHETORIC OF PROMISE WHICH HAS OFTEN SUFFICED IN THE

PAST AND THE FAILURE OF THE DEMOCRAT PARTY AS AN INSTITUTION TO

ADAPT TO THE NEEDS OF THIS CHANGING ELECTORATE. IT IS NO LONGER

GOOD ENOUGH TO CALL FOR PEACE AND OFFER ECONOMIC NOSTRUMS WHILE

FAILING TO TAKE THE NECESSARY ACTIONS TO CREATE PEACE AND PROSPERITY.

WHAT THE PEOPLE OF AMERICA WANT ARE PROGRAMS -- AND THEY ARE NOT

GETTING THOSE PROGRAMS FROM ANY OF THE CANDIDATES CURRENTLY

VYING FOR THE DEMOCRAT PRESIDENTIAL NOMINATION. BUT THEY ARE GETTING

ACTION FROM PRESIDENT NIXON.

THIS SHOULD HAVE BEGUN TO DAWN ON DEMOCRAT LEADERS MANY YEARS AGO, FOR BY THE SIMPLE ARITHMETIC OF PARTY REGISTRATION FIGURES, NEITHER PRESIDENT EISENHOWER NOR PRESIDENT NIXON OUGHT TO HAVE BEEN ELECTED.

BUT THEY WERE ELECTED -- AND PRESIDENT NIXON WILL BE ELECTED

AGAIN -- BECAUSE THE VOTERS CHOOSE CANDIDATES WITH RATIONAL PROGRAMS

AND PROVEN RECORDS OF SUCCESS. ONE LOOKS IN VAIN FOR POTENTIAL

CANDIDATES WITHIN THE DEMOCRAT PARTY WHO MEET EITHER OF THOSE CRITERIA.

UP TO US

I CAN'T HELP WONDERING, HOWEVER, WHAT ALL THE FUSS IS ABOUT.

EACH OF THE DEMOCRATS CAN DO WHATEVER HE WANTS TO FURTHER HIS OWN

PERSONAL POLITICAL AMBITIONS. EACH OF THEM CAN DO WHATEVER HE

WANTS TO PROMOTE A STOP MC GOVERN MOVEMENT.

BUT NO MATTER WHAT THEY DO, IT IS GOING TO BE WHAT WE REPUBLICANS DO, IN THE FINAL ANALYSIS, THAT WILL MAKE THE DIFFERENCE.

IF WE DO OUR PART AND MAKE THE RECORD OF THIS PRESIDENT AND THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF HIS ADMINISTRATION KNOWN TO THE VOTERS, THEN THAT WILL GIVE US THE STRONGEST STOP MC GOVERN, OR STOP MUSKIE, OR STOP KENNEDY OR STOP HUMPHREY MOVEMENT CONCEIVALBLE.

IT REALLY IS UP TO US. THE PRESIDENT HAS ALREADY DONE HIS PART.

HE HAS GIVEN THIS COUNTRY THE LEADERSHIP IT NEEDS. HE HAS GIVEN IT

THE KIND OF LEADERSHIP FOR PEACE AND PROSPERITY THAT IT HAD BEEN

WITHOUT FOR MUCH TOO LONG DURING MOST OF THE LAST DECADE.

WHETHER THE COUNTRY'S VOTERS MAKE THEIR DECISION TO CONTINUE

THE PROGRESS WE HAVE MADE UNDER RICHARD NIXON FOR ANOTHERFFOUR YEARS,

OR DECIDE TO GO BACK TO REPEAT THE DEMOCRATS' MISTAKES OF THE PAST

IS GOING TO DEPEND ON US AND ON REPUBLICANS THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY.

THERE AREN'T ENOUGH OF US TO ELECT THE PRESIDENT ON OUR OWN.

WE HAVE TO CONVINCE DEMOCRATS AND INDEPENDENTS, WE HAVE TO TELL THEM ABOUT THE NIXON RECORD. WE HAVE TO MAKE SURE IT IS UNDERSTOOD.

AND WE CAN'T ASSUME THAT EVERYONE KNOWS IT AS WELL AS YOU AND I.

AND NEITHER CAN WE ASSUME THAT THE DEMOCRATS, IN SPITE OF THEIR PRESENT STATE OF CONFUSION, WILL BE PUSH-OVERS. NO MATTER WHO THEIR CANDIDATEIS, THEY WILL PUT UP A TOUGH FIGHT. THEIR AMBITION IS TOO STRONG.

SO I REPEAT, IT IS UP TO US, IN NO SMALL WAY. THE COUNTRY
IS GOING TO DECIDE IN NOVEMBER WHETHER IT WILL RELIVE THE PAST -AND THE MISTAKES OF THE PAST -- WITH THE DEMOCRATS, OR WHETHER IT IS
GOING TO CHART THE FUTURE, A FUTURE OF PEACE AND PROSPERITY BASED ON
PEACE WITH THE REPUBLICAN LEADERSHIP OF RICHARD NIXON.
