THESE PROJECTS ARE CONTAINED WITHIN PRESIDENT REAGAN'S FY'87
BUDGET AND HAVE BEEN ON THE BOOKS FOR YEARS. THE PRESIDENT HAS
RECOMMENDED THAT \$2.6 MILLION BE APPROVED FOR THE GREAT BEND
FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT AND \$1.1 MILLION BE APPROVED FOR HALSTEAD.
