REMARKS OF SENATOR BOB DOLE PENNSYLVANIA GOP LINCOLN DAY DINNER FEBRUARY 26, 1987 ADAMS MARK HOTEL, PHILADELPHIA, PENNSYLVANIA

INTRODUCTION

IT'S A PLEASURE TO BE HERE TODAY. THIS MAY TURN OUT TO BE A RATHER PIVOTAL DAY FOR OUR COUNTRY'S FUTURE OVER THE NEXT COUPLE OF YEARS.

RELEASE OF TOWER COMMISSION REPORT

THE TOWER COMMISSION -- APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT IN THE AFTERMATH OF THE IRAN-CONTRA AFFAIR -- WAS RELEASED THIS MORNING. I'M SURE - 2 -

THAT ALL OF US HERE IN WASHINGTON AND AROUND THE COUNTRY ARE GOING TO BE LOOKING AT IT, AND REACTING TO IT, OVER THE NEXT DAYS AND WEEKS. AND THE WAY WE REACT IS GOING TO BE TERRIBLY IMPORTANT TO OUR COUNTRY.

I JOINED THE PRESIDENT IN WELCOMING THE RELEASE OF THE REPORT. IT CAN BE A MAJOR STEP IN HELPING US TAKE THE CORRECTIVE ACTIONS NECESSARY AND GETTING THE ISSUE BEHIND US.

UNFORTUNATELY, IT'S ALREADY OBVIOUS THAT COLOSSAL BLUNDERS WERE MADE. SOME ORGANIZATIONAL AND PERSONNEL CHANGES MAY BE NEEDED. BUT THAT'S ULTIMATELY THE PRESIDENT'S CALL. - 3 -

ONE IMMEDIATE AND NECESSARY STEP IS FOR THE PRESIDENT TO MAKE IT CLEAR TO EVERYONE THAT HIS HAND IS FIRMLY ON THE RUDDER -- THAT HE'S IN CHARGE, THAT HE'S MAKING THE DECISIONS, AND THAT THERE IS VIGOROUS FOLLOW-UP TO INSURE THOSE DECISIONS ARE BEING FAITHFULLY IMPLEMENTED. I'M CONFIDENT THE PRESIDENT WILL BE TAKING THOSE STEPS. I HAVEN'T HAD THE CHANCE TO READ THE ENTIRE REPORT YET. BUT AS WE DIGEST AND ACT ON THE REPORT, LET'S KEEP SEVERAL IMPORTANT THINGS IN MIND.

PRESIDENT TOOK INITIATIVE TO GET TRUTH OUT FIRST, IT WAS THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES WHO CREATED THE TOWER COMMISSION. HE DIDN'T HAVE TO. BUT HE DID. BECAUSE HE WANTED - 4 -

THE TRUTH TO BE TOLD. NOT BECAUSE THE REVELATIONS WE SEE IN THIS REPORT, AND ELSEWHERE, ARE NECESSARILY THE BEST THING IN THE WORLD FOR RONALD REAGAN. BUT BECAUSE GETTING THE TRUTH OUT IS BEST FOR THE COUNTRY.

IT WAS THE PRESIDENT, TOO, WHO ORDERED THE APPOINTMENT OF A SO-CALLED INDEPENDENT COUNSEL -- A SPECIAL PROSECUTOR. HE DIDN'T <u>HAVE</u> TO. BUT HE DID. BECAUSE HE WANTED THE TRUTH TO BE TOLD.

AND IT WAS THE PRESIDENT -- PRESIDENT <u>REAGAN</u> -- WHO HAS PLEDGED HIS COOPERATION TO THE VARIOUS CONGRESSIONAL INVESTIGATIONS. AND WHO HAS <u>DELIVERED</u> ON THAT PLEDGE. IN FACT, DELIVERED TO SUCH A DEGREE THAT SOME HAVE - 5 -

QUESTIONED WHETHER HE HAS TURNED OVER TO CONGRESS SOME MATERIAL HE SHOULDN'T HAVE. BUT THE PRESIDENT HAS GONE AHEAD AND GIVEN CONGRESS EVERYTHING IT HAS ASKED FOR. AND, AS WE HAVE SEEN IN OUR HISTORY, THE PRESIDENT DIDN'T <u>HAVE</u> TO DO THIS. BUT THIS PRESIDENT HAS. BECAUSE HE WANTS THE TRUTH TO BE TOLD.

THERE HAS BEEN <u>NO</u> COVER-UP; <u>NO</u> STONEWALLING; <u>NO</u> DUCKING RESPONSIBILITY. AT LEAST <u>NOT</u> BY THE PRESIDENT. THE COMMISSION ITSELF CONCLUDED, AND THIS IS A QUOTE FROM THE REPORT: "THE BOARD IS CONVINCED THAT THE PRESIDENT DOES INDEED WANT THE FULL STORY OUT."

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AND IT SEEMS TO ME THAT, <u>ALONE</u>, IS ONE MARK OF THE KIND OF LEADERSHIP WE HAVE HAD FROM THIS PRESIDENT, AND ARE GOING TO CONTINUE TO HAVE THE NEXT TWO YEARS.

SO AS WE HEAR ABOUT, AND THINK ABOUT, THE TOWER COMMISSION REPORT, AND MAKE OUR OWN JUDGMENTS ABOUT "WHO SHOT JOHN" -- LET'S KEEP THIS VERY MUCH IN MIND: THE PRESIDENT SHOT <u>NO</u> ONE. AND HE HAS LED -- <u>LED</u> -- THE FIGHT TO FIND OUT WHO DID.

AND THAT BRINGS ME TO THE SECOND POINT THAT WE SHOULD KEEP IN MIND. AND IN MANY WAYS, THIS IS EVEN MORE IMPORTANT. - 7 -

MUCH REMAINS THE SAME, DESPITE REPORT AFTER TONIGHT'S NEWS SHOWS, TOMORROW'S HEADLINES, AND ALL THE COMMENTARY AND DEBATE WE ARE GOING TO HAVE OVER THE NEXT COUPLE OF DAYS -- SOME THINGS ARE <u>NOT</u> GOING TO BE ANY DIFFERENT AT ALL.

RONALD REAGAN IS <u>STILL</u> GOING TO BE THE PRESIDENT. AND HE'S GOING TO REMAIN THE PRESIDENT UNTIL JANUARY 20, 1989 -- AND THAT'S TWO YEARS AWAY.

AND THE ENORMOUS PROBLEMS THIS COUNTRY FACES -- THOSE PROBLEMS ARE <u>NOT</u> GOING TO CHANGE BECAUSE THE TOWER COMMISSION HAS FINISHED ITS WORK. THEY WILL STILL BE THERE, AS DAUNTING AS EVER. - 8 -

AND NEITHER WILL WE LOSE THE OPPORTUNITIES WE HAVE AS A COUNTRY AND AS AMERICANS. THOSE OPPORTUNITIES -- TO ACHIEVE SUSTAINED PROSPERITY AT HOME; TO ASSERT OUR LEADERSHIP IN THE FREE WORLD; TO EXPAND THE FRONTIERS OF FREEDOM AROUND THE GLOBE -- THEY WILL STILL BE THERE, BEFORE AMERICA, BEFORE US.

AND THE FUNDAMENTAL QUESTIONS WILL REMAIN: CAN WE OVERCOME THE PROBLEMS? CAN WE SEIZE THE OPPORTUNITIES, AND DO THE NATION'S WORK?

TWO CHOICES

WE BASICALLY HAVE TWO CHOICES, NO MATTER WHAT TURNS OUT TO BE IN THE TOWER COMMISSION REPORT.

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WE CAN REMAIN PREOCCUPIED WITH CRITICISM; WITH FINDING OUT WHO TO BLAME AND FIRE; WITH EXPRESSING DOOM AND GLOOM FOR THE COUNTRY AND THE PRESIDENT.

OR WE CAN ACCEPT THE FACTS IN THE REPORT; DEAL WITH THEM; AND, THEN, GET BACK TO THE OTHER WORK OF THE COUNTRY. TOGETHER. WITH THE PRESIDENT. WITH HIS LEADERSHIP. AND UNITED. CERTAINLY NOT ON EVERYTHING. BUT AT LEAST ON THIS: THAT WE ARE <u>ALL</u> AMERICANS. THAT WE <u>ALL</u> WANT A STRONG AMERICA. AND THAT WE'RE <u>NOT</u> GOING TO HAVE IT, UNLESS WE HAVE A STRONG PRESIDENT.

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IF WE FALTER, OUR ADVERSARIES WILL PROSPER BECAUSE, MAKE NO MISTAKE ABOUT IT, IF WE DON'T JOIN TOGETHER, THERE ARE PLENTY OF PROBLEMS IN THIS COUNTRY THAT ARE GOING TO GET OUT OF HAND. AND PLENTY OF PEOPLE AROUND THE GLOBE -- FROM MOSCOW TO MANAGUA, FROM TRIPOLI TO TEHERAN -- WHO ARE MORE THAN READY TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF OUR DISUNITY OR DISCORD.

YOU CAN SAY MANY THINGS ABOUT MR. GORBACHEV -- AND ON ANOTHER OCCASION, I'D BE HAPPY TO <u>SAY</u> A FEW OF THOSE THINGS -- BUT ONE THING YOU CAN'T DENY. HE <u>IS</u> PRESENTING US WITH A VERY FORMIDABLE POLITICAL CHALLENGE.

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ADROIT, MODERN-LOOKING DIPLOMACY, THAT SEEKS TO BLUR THE FUNDAMENTAL DIFFERENCES BETWEEN COMMUNISM AND FREEDOM. WELL, WE DON'T HAVE TO WONDER ANY MORE.

BUT <u>NEITHER</u> DO WE HAVE TO DESPAIR. NOT IF WE ARE UNITED.

GORBACHEV MAY BE -- LET'S FACE IT, IS --GREAT AT P.R. BUT HE'S GOT A LOUSY PRODUCT. AND WE CAN SHOW HOW LOUSY IT IS BY OUR OWN PERFORMANCE, AS A NATION AND A PEOPLE.

BUT ONLY IF WE WORK TOGETHER.

THE CHALLENGES WE FACE: AT HOME ...

WHAT DO WE HAVE TO DO? WE HAVE TO PUT OUR OWN ECONOMIC HOUSE IN ORDER, AND MAKE SURE IT STAYS THAT WAY. THE FIRST PRIORITIES THERE ARE

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TO DO SOMETHING DRASTIC AND PERMANENT ABOUT REDUCING FEDERAL BUDGET DEFICITS; AND TO MAKE SURE THAT WE DON'T RETREAT ON THE PRINCIPLES OF TAX REFORM, WHICH ARE ESSENTIAL TO OUR LONG-TERM ECONOMIC VITALITY.

WE HAVE TO DO SOMETHING QUICKLY AND VIGOROUSLY ABOUT TRADE DEFICITS. I KNOW THAT IS A VERY HIGH PRIORITY TO THIS INDUSTRY. BUT IF WE ARE TO DO SOMETHING THAT WORKS, WE'RE GOING TO HAVE TO AVOID THE TRAP OF TURNING THIS INTO AN IRRATIONAL, PARTISAN, BIDDING CONTEST FOR POPULARITY AMONG COMPETING INTEREST GROUPS.

WE NEED A SOUND, COMPREHENSIVE, BIPARTISAN APPROACH THAT WILL SHOW THOSE WHO DON'T TRADE FAIRLY THAT WE MEAN BUSINESS; PROVE TO THOSE

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WHO DO THAT WE DO NOT SEEK TO PENALIZE THEM; AND WHICH GETS AT BOTH THE SHORT-RUN PROBLEMS, AND THE LONG-TERM SOLUTIONS, TO THIS TERRIBLE NATIONAL PROBLEM.

... AND AROUND THE WORLD

AND WE MUST MOVE, MOST URGENTLY OF ALL, TO INSURE THAT AMERICA REMAINS THE STRONGEST NATION ON EARTH, BOTH MILITARILY AND POLITICALLY.

WE START BY FACING THIS TRUTH: A STRONG DEFENSE COSTS MONEY -- <u>BIG</u> MONEY. THAT DOESN'T MEAN WE HAVE TO TOLERATE WASTE IN THE PENTAGON. THERE IS NO GROUP THAT KNOWS ANY BETTER THAN THIS ONE THAT TOILET SEATS AND SCREWS <u>DON'T</u> COST THOUSANDS OF DOLLARS.

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BUT WE HAVE TO BE <u>SECOND TO NONE</u> IN OUR MILITARY TECHNOLOGY. WE HAVE TO BE SECOND TO NONE IN THE QUALITY OF OUR MILITARY PERSONNEL. AND WE HAVE TO BE SECOND TO NONE IN OUR WILLINGNESS TO BEAR THE COST OF FREEDOM.

AND, TOO, WE HAVE TO MATCH OUR MILITARY STRENGTH WITH A STRONG, ACTIVE FOREIGN POLICY. ARMS CONTROL REMAINS AT THE TOP OF OUR AGENDA. REYKJAVIK REPRESENTED A WATERSHED. IT WAS THE FIRST TIME AN AMERICAN PRESIDENT AND A SOVIET LEADER TALKED SERIOUSLY ABOUT LARGE REDUCTIONS -- NOT LIMITS, BUT ACTUAL REDUCTIONS -- OF NUCLEAR STOCKPILES. AND IT RESULTED IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF NEGOTIATING OUTLINES WHICH CAN

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PROVIDE THE FRAMEWORK FOR ACTUAL AGREEMENTS. IF THE SOVIETS WILL JUST NEGOTIATE IN GOOD FAITH.

AND WE HAVE OTHER IMPORTANT INTERNATIONAL TASKS. WE HAVE ONLY BEGUN TO FIGURE OUT HOW TO DEAL WITH THE SCOURGE OF THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN DRUGS. WE HAVE NOT EVEN GOTTEN <u>THAT</u> FAR IN COMING UP WITH A STRATEGY TO STOP INTERNATIONAL TERRORISM. AND WE HAVE STILL TO PROVE THAT WE WILL MEET OUR RESPONSIBILITY, AND MATCH OUR RINGING RHETORIC, BY PROVIDING REAL, SUSTAINED SUPPORT FOR PEOPLE FIGHTING FOR THEIR FREEDOM AROUND THE GLOBE.

WE CAN DO WHAT NEEDS TO BE DONE

THESE CHALLENGES ARE ENORMOUS. BUT SO ARE AMERICAN RESOURCES AND INGENUITY.

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WE HAVE SPENT AND SPENT, UNTIL OUR FEDERAL DEFICITS HAVE GOTTEN OUT OF HAND. WE <u>OUGHT</u> TO BE ABLE TO MUSTER THE WILL AND THE WAYS TO GET THEM BACK UNDER CONTROL.

WE USED TO BE WAY AHEAD OF THE PACK IN SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND WORLD TRADE. WE <u>SHOULD</u> BE ABLE TO FIND OUR WAY BACK INTO THE LEAD.

WE CREATED THE FIRST NUCLEAR WEAPONS. AND NOW WE HAVE A RESPONSIBILITY TO LEAD THE SEARCH FOR WAYS TO RENDER THEM OBSOLETE.

AMERICA HAS PROBLEMS. BUT WE HAVE ONE THING IN MUCH GREATER MEASURE: PROMISE. OUR PROMISE AS A NATION AND AS A PEOPLE.

SO, LET US PICK UP THE TOWER REPORT, READ IT CAREFULLY AND TAKE WHATEVER LESSONS IT HAS TO OFFER.

AND THEN LET'S PUT IT DOWN, AND GET BACK TO THE NATION'S BUSINESS.
