BUSH TAKES THE LEAD ON ISSUES

PRESIDENT BUSH IS TAKING THE LEAD ON ALL THE MAJOR
ISSUES. DRUGS, FOR EXAMPLE. IT'S HIS NUMBER ONE
PRIORITY AND HE'S APPROACHED THE WAR ON DRUGS AS
JUST THAT -- A WAR. TOUGH ON DEALERS, TOUGH ON USERS,
MORE PRISONS, MORE POLICE, MORE COURTS.

HE HASN'T NEGLECTED THE NEED FOR TREATMENT AND
THE NEED FOR EDUCATION. BUT HE KNOWS IT WAS THE
LIBERALS PERMISSIVENESS OF THE '60'S THAT CREATED THE
DRUG PROBLEM IN THE FIRST PLACE. WITHHOLDING THE
STIFF HAND OF DISCIPLINE NOW WILL ONLY PROLONG THE
PROBLEM IN THE '80'S.



BUT HIS PLAN WAS MET WITH DEMOCRATIC

CRITICISM...AND REFLEXIVE RESPONSES CALLING FOR HIGHER
TAXES. AND ON CAPITOL HILL THE DEMOCRAT-CONTROLLED
POWER STRUCTURE HAS DIVIDED AND DELAYED THE
NATIONAL ATTEMPT TO TACKLE THIS ISSUE.

HAND-IN HAND WITH THE SCOURGE OF DRUGS GOES THE

AGAIN, THE DEMOCRATS TURNED PLAYED POLITICS --

BOTTLING UP SOME THE PRESIDENT'S MOST IMPORTANT INITIATIVES IN THEIR DEMOCRATICALLY-CONTROLLED COMMITTEES.

ROOSEVELT...THE PARTY THAT CREATED THE ENVIRONMENTAL
PROTECTION AGENCY...WILL MAKE SURE OUR KIDS INHERIT A

WALL, ASKING ONLY TWO THINGS: FREEDOM AND
OPPORTUNITY.

THE PEOPLE OF EAST GERMANY, AND THE RAPID MARCH
OF CONTEMPORARY HISTORY HAVE LEFT THEM WITH ONLY
ONE REASONABLE CHOICE: TO GO DOWN THE PATH THAT
POLAND AND HUNGARY ARE ALREADY FOLLOWING.
