Attaboy

It must be an election year.

While we hadn't seen much of him in a while, suddenly Sen. Bob Dole seems to be everywhere at once.

That's not a criticism. It's an observation.

Hutchinson hosted the senator during the recent ceremony to kick off the expansion of the Kansas Cosmosphere and Space Center. Two weeks later he appeared at the Sterling College graduation and at Hutchinson Heights, a residential center for the physically disabled, and then attended a political function at the home of Hutchinson resident R.A. Edwards.

In the politics of the presidency, H. Ross Perot, the noncandidate candidate, says if elected he would spend most of his time in Washington attending to the nation's business, and not holding photo opportunities in the Rose Garden. That's a good idea. But as Dole has recently proven, visits home are often more fruitful for constituents than their elected leaders.

While at Sterling College, Dole gave a significant speech. Rather than merely applaud the graduates for their success, certainly a worthy theme, Dole took the opportunity to call for an economic blockade against Serbia, not only a national story, but an international one. The graduates had suddenly been placed in an international arena, the real world, the one they will soon enter and live in. And they arrived via the coattails of one of the more statesman-like leaders

of a nation that needs more of them.

At Hutchinson Heights, a unique care facility whose opening Dole attended in 1986, the senator strolled among the 15 severely handicapped residents with ease. Accepting the invitation of Hutchinson resident Virginia Hulet, whose son, Kyle, lives at the facility Dole spent 30 minutes patiently speaking to individuals and touring the facility. Staff members and parents took the opportunity to articulate the needs of the center and how the government could help.

The significance of such visits should not be lost. It is one thing to use all visits home for purely political purposes; it's quite another to come home to hear from constituents. Too often, as is the case in presidential politics, candidates do more talking than listening. A good case can be made for those participating in campaigns to do both. That is how Bob Dole spent his Saturday, pressing a little flesh, listening to taxpayers and getting out from behind the wall around Washington to witness the real America.

He was accessible. And that's what voters want. Politicians don't need another picture of themselves posed against a candidate. They don't need slick lobbyists to press their case. They can do that quite well themselves in their own way. Dole provided that opportunity for his constituents. We would urge more of it, especially in this season of discontent, in which America is sick and tired of the status quo.
