*It would also be improper for the Attorney General and the FBI Director to attend an event paid for by the campaign.

*Although I have not brought it up directly, I believe either the U.S. Attorney's Office or the City of Topeka would be happy to pay the room rental fee.

*Judy has done some investigating to determine the cost of meals. A light lunch would run approximately \$8.00 a person. Another room would also be necessary with an additional rental fee. Again, this could not be paid for out of official funds.
