On behalf of The Junior Statesmen Foundation, it is my pleasure to cordially invite you to participate as a guest speaker in The Junior Statesmen Summer School program.

Two hundred of America's future leaders have been selected to participate in this annual summer session. They will be spending three weeks at Georgetown University in an intensive study of politics and government. Each summer, our sessions at the White House and on Capitol Hill allow these high school students to meet and question Cabinet Secretaries, leaders in the House and Senate, Supreme Court Justices, prominent journalists, lobbyists, and others in the political arena.

The format we prefer is brief opening remarks on a political issue of concern to you followed by questions and answers.
