SERIOUSLY, IT IS A PLEASURE TO SERVE AS MASTER OF **CEREMONIES AT THIS** CELEBRATION MARKING PRESIDENT FORD'S 80TH BIRTHDAY, BETTY'S 75TH **BIRTHDAY, AND THEIR 45TH** WEDDING ANNIVERSARY. AS YOU MAY KNOW, JERRY DOESN'T TURN 80 UNTIL JULY,

AFTER THE CAMPAIGN RALLY
WITH 10,000 PEOPLE WHO HAD
SOMEHOW CROWDED INTO THE
COURTHOUSE SQUARE, MY

MOTHER INVITED JERRY TO HER HOUSE FOR SOME REFRESHMENTS.

UNFORTUNATELY, SOMEONE
HAD TAKEN VISITORS THROUGH
THE HOUSE EARLIER IN THE
DAY, LOCKED THE DOOR, AND
HAD FORGOTTEN TO PUT MY
MOTHER'S SPARE KEY BACK IN
ITS USUAL PLACE. SO, THERE I

STOOD WITH THE PRESIDENT,
LOCKED OUT OF MY OWN
HOUSE. AFTER A FRANTIC
SEARCH, ELIZABETH FOUND THE
KEY BEHIND A DRAIN PIPE.

ELIZABETH DID ASK ME TO
EXTEND HER GREETINGS THIS
EVENING. SHE WANTED TO BE
HERE, BUT SHE HAD TO ATTEND
A MEETING OF THE HARVARD

**BOARD OF OVERSEERS...** SOMEONE HAS TO KEEP AN EYE ON ALL THOSE LIBERALS. **ELIZABETH ALSO ASKED ME** TO SAY THAT RED CROSS **BLOOD SUPPLIES ARE A BIT** LOW RIGHT NOW, SO SHE WAS HOPING, JERRY, THAT YOU COULD STAY OFF THE GOLF COURSE FOR A WEEK OR TWO.

I ALSO BRING GREETINGS THIS EVENING FROM PRESIDENT REAGAN. I SAW THE PRESIDENT AND NANCY WHEN I WAS IN CALIFORNIA LAST WEEK. HE TOLD ME THAT HE THOUGHT I WAS STILL A BIT YOUNG TO BE PRESIDENT, BUT THAT JERRY WAS JUST THE RIGHT AGE.

**ACTUALLY, JERRY, I HAVE A** DIFFERENT PROPOSITION FOR YOU THIS EVENING. IN YOUR POLITICAL CAREER, YOU'VE SERVED AS CONGRESSMAN, **VICE PRESIDENT, AND** PRESIDENT. IT SEEMS TO ME THERE'S ONE THING MISSING. YOU HAVEN'T BEEN ELECTED TO THE SENATE.

AND THERE JUST HAPPENS TO BE A SEAT OPEN IN MICHIGAN NEXT YEAR...WE PAY ALL RELOCATION COSTS, AND **WE'LL EVEN MAKE YOU** REPUBLICAN LEADER. IF **ANYONE THINKS YOU'RE TOO** OLD, JUST REMIND THEM THAT STROM THURMOND STILL CALLS YOU "JUNIOR."

I DID A LITTLE RESEARCH **BEFORE COMING HERE THIS EVENING, AND I HAPPENED A** COPY OF AMERICAN HERITAGE MAGAZINE. BACK IN 1988, THE MAGAZINE ASKED THE NATION'S LEADING HISTORIANS AND SCHOLARS TO RATE WHO WAS THE MOST OVERRATED AND THE MOST UNDERRATED

FIGURE IN AMERICAN HISTORY---NOT JUST IN THIS DECADE, OR LAST DECADE--BUT IN AMERICAN HISTORY. AND ONE OF AMERICA'S **MOST RESPECTED HISTORIANS--PULITZER PRIZE WINNER EDMUND MORRIS--SAID THAT** THE MOST UNDER-RATED

PERSON IN AMERICAN HISTORY WAS JERRY FORD. AND NO DOUBT ABOUT IT, FROM RESTORING THE AMERICAN PEOPLE'S CONFIDENCE IN THEIR **GOVERNMENT....TO CUTTING** INFLATION BY MORE THAN HALF...TO HAVING THE COURAGE TO VETO BUDGET

**BUSTING LEGISLATION TIME AND** TIME AGAIN...TO REDUCING THE ARMS RACE....AMERICA IS FOR THE BETTER BECAUSE JERRY FORD WAS PRESIDENT. I'VE LONG BELIEVED THAT **JERRY FORD WAS PRECISELY** THE RIGHT PERSON TO LEAD AMERICA IN HER BICENTENNIAL YEAR, BECAUSE JERRY FORD IS

WHAT AMERICA IS ALL ABOUT--HARD WORK, HONESTY, DECENCY, AND COMPASSION. AND I'M ONE WHO BELIEVES THAT OF ALL THE BENEFITS THE FORD ADMINISTRATION GAVE TO AMERICA, ONE OF THE **GREATEST WAS HAVING BETTY** FORD AS AMERICA'S FIRST LADY.

I'VE BEEN CALLED MANY THINGS DURING MY POLITICAL CAREER. BUT ONE OF THE BIGGEST COMPLIMENTS I RECEIVED WAS WHEN SOMEONE CALLED ME THE "BETTY FORD OF PROSTATE CANCER." WHEN MY DOCTOR GAVE ME THE DIAGNOSIS OF PROSTATE CANCER A WHILE BACK, I

THOUGHT ABOUT HOW I WOULD HANDLE IT.

PROSTATE CANCER IS NOT A TOPIC FOLKS LIKE TO DISCUSS, AND SOME URGED ME TO HAVE THE SURGERY DONE WITH AS LITTLE PUBLICITY AS POSSIBLE. **BUT THE MORE I THOUGHT** ABOUT MY DIAGNOSIS, THE MORE I THOUGHT ABOUT BETTY FORD, AND HOW SHE HANDLED HER BATTLE WITH BREAST CANCER. BY TALKING ABOUT IT **OPENLY AND HONESTLY, SHE ENCOURAGED OTHER WOMEN** TO SEE THEIR DOCTORS, AND SHE SAVED MANY LIVES. SO I DID AS BETTY HAD DONE. I LEARNED AS MUCH ABOUT THE

DISEASE AS I COULD, AND I

WENT PUBLIC, DISCUSSING THE IMPORTANCE OF EARLY DIAGNOSIS.

SO, THANK YOU BETTY, FOR
YOUR COURAGE, AND FOR ALL
THE LIVES YOU HAVE SAVED
AND THE LIVES YOU CONTINUE
TO TURN AROUND AT THE BETTY
FORD CENTER.
