WELCOME SENATOR DOLE, AND WELCOME TO FUSION POLITICS.

FUSION POLITICS IS NEW YORK CITY'S IDIOMATIC EXPRESSION FOR DIPLOMACY. IT BRINGS PEOPLE TOGETHER, AND IT GETS THINGS DONE.

WE ARE EMPHASIZING OUR SHARED NEEDS AND OUR COMMON DESTINY.

FUSION POLITICS TAKES LESSONS FROM BUSINESS AND LABOR:

IT SAYS YOU WORK BOTH SIDES OF THE AISLE IN ALBANY AND IN WASHINGTON - BECAUSE THERE ARE TWO SIDES AND VERY LITTLE GETS DONE IN AMERICA WITHOUT THE TWO SIDES COMING TOGETHER.

IT IS TEMPTING TO SAY THAT NEW YORK CITY IS THE EXCEPTION TO THAT RULE -- MANY SAY THAT NEW YORK IS A ONE PARTY CITY. BUT THAT'S SIMPLISTIC.

EVEN IN NEW YORK, A DEMOCRAT WHO CAN'T WORK WITH REPUBLICANS IS AS USELESS AS A REPUBLICAN WHO WON'T WORK WITH DEMOCRATS.

THAT'S WHY FUSION IS THE MOST RESPONSIVE FORM OF GOVERNMENT NEW YORK CITY CAN HAVE AND IN TIMES OF FISCAL CRISIS IT IS VITAL.

FOR THE NEXT FOUR YEARS, NEW YORK CITY WILL NEED ALL THE HELP IT CAN GET.

AND WHEN I'M MAYOR, FUSION WILL NOT ONLY BE THE MEANS THAT PUT US IN OFFICE, BUT THE VERY METHOD THAT WILL PUT OUR POLICIES INTO PRACTICE.

MY ADMINISTRATION WILL INCLUDE DEMOCRATS AND REPUBLICANS, LIBERALS, CONSERVATIVES AND INDEPENDENTS. WE'LL COME TOGETHER IN A BROAD-BASED COALITION THAT WILL REPLACE THE CLUBHOUSE MEDIOCRITY AND DULL SPIRIT THAT ONE-PARTY POLITICS CREATES.

AND IN THE YEARS AHEAD, AS NEW YORK CITY SLIMS DOWN TO FIT THROUGH THE NARROW DOOR THAT LEADS TO FISCAL STABILITY, WE WILL HAVE TO CALL ON MANY AMERICANS WITH MANY IDEOLOGIES -- FROM WASHINGTON TO ALBANY TO NEW YORK -- TO RESTORE AND REVITALIZE OUR CITY.

FUSION POLITICS IS NOT SPARED THE POLITICAL IOU OF BEING BEHOLDEN, BUT IT DOES SPARE THE PEOPLE FROM BEING BEHOLDEN TO ONE PARTY. FUSION POLITICS WORKS BECAUSE IT INCLUDES. IT BRINGS MORE PEOPLE IN AT THE START SO FEWER ARE LEFT OUT IN THE END.

ASK BOB DOLE.

HE IS MR. REPUBLICAN, BUT LAST WEEK, MR. REPUBLICAN SAT DOWN IN A WASHINGTON RESTAURANT AND HAD DINNER WITH THE PRESIDENT. TWO MEN SEEKING COMMON GROUND.

IN NEW YORK CITY, BOB, THAT'S CALLED "FUSION POLITICS".

BUT NO MATTER WHAT WE CALL IT, YOU PRACTICE IT WELL.

YOU ARE YOUR STATE'S SENIOR SENATOR, BUT YOUR INTEREST TRANSCENDS THE OPEN PLAINS OF KANSAS AND EMBRACES THE CROWDED AND BROODING STREETS OF OUR GREAT CITIES.

YOU UNDERSTAND THAT FUNDAMENTAL FACT OF AMERICAN LIFE -NO MATTER OUR DIFFERENCES -- AND THEY ARE GREAT, AND THEY CAN BE
DIVISIVE -- OUR DESTINIES ARE FUSED BY TIME AND SPACE AND A
POLITICAL PROCESS AND A COMMON BOND AS AMERICANS.

I PROMISE YOU AND YOUR COLLEAGUE THAT I WON'T ABUSE THAT PROCESS.

BEFORE I GO TO WASHINGTON, I'M GOING TO CLEAN UP OUR ACT BACK HOME.

YOU WON'T SEE US IN WASHINGTON ASKING FOR MORE MONEY, WHEN AT THE SAME TIME WE'RE FAILING TO FILL 1, 600 HEAD START SLOTS BECAUSE THE ADMINISTRATION CAN'T GET THE PAPER WORK DONE ON TIME.

YOU WON'T SEE US IN WASHINGTON, LOOKING FOR MORE FEDERAL DOLLARS WHEN AT THE SAME TIME WE'RE FAILING TO SPEND FUNDS FOR OUR UNEMPLOYED UNDER THE FAMILY SUPPORT ACT.

YOU WON'T SEE US IN WASHINGTON, TOUTING THE GREATNESS OF A CITY WHEN AT THE SAME TIME WE'RE SENDING TAXES AND FINES THROUGH THE ROOF AND DRIVING THE MIDDLE CLASS OUT THE DOOR.

WHEN YOU SEE US AGAIN, SENATOR, YOU'LL FIND THAT NEW YORK CAN GIVE AS WELL AS TAKE. YOU'LL FIND THAT WE'VE GIVEN THE BOOT TO POLITICS AS USUAL, GIVEN THE BOOT TO BLOAT AND SMUG SELF-INDULGENCE.

BUT WE'RE HONORED THAT BEFORE WE GO TO WASHINGTON TO SEE YOU, YOU'VE COME TO NEW YORK TO SEE US. AND TO SHOW OUR APPRECIATION, WE'VE EVEN TREATED YOU TO A GOOD OLD-FASHIONED, CORNBELT HEAT WAVE, PROVING THAT THERE'S STILL NO SUCH THING AS COLD FUSION.

SO, ON BEHALF OF YOUR MANY ADMIRERS AND FRIENDS, I WELCOME YOU TO OUR NATION'S FIRST CITY.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, IT IS MY GREAT PLEASURE TO INTRODUCE, MY FRIEND, THE MINORITY LEADER OF THE UNTIED STATES SENATE, SENATOR BOB DOLE.

\*BEFORE I WAS SHIPPED **OVERSEAS IN WORLD WAR II, I** SPENT A NUMBER OF MONTHS HERE IN AN ENGINEERING CLASS AT BROOKLYN COLLEGE. \*NO DOUBT ABOUT IT. FOR A **BOY FROM RUSSELL, KANSAS, NEW YORK CITY WAS A TRUE** EDUCATION. \*EACH DAY I RODE THE SUBWAY OR WALKED THE

STREETS, I SAW CULTURES AND HEARD ACCENTS THAT WERE COMPLETELY NEW TO ME.

\*BUT I'VE GOT TO BELIEVE
