**\*UNDER THIS PROPOSAL,  
SINGLE-PARENT AND TWO-  
PARENT FAMILIES WHO WISH TO  
RESIDE WITHIN THE ZONES  
WOULD VOLUNTARILY APPLY  
FOR ADMISSION. ONCE**

**ADMITTED, THEY WOULD  
RECEIVE CERTAIN BENEFITS--  
BETTER SECURITY, DECENT  
HOUSING, AND THE  
OPPORTUNITY TO SEND THEIR  
CHILDREN TO A SCHOOL OF  
THEIR CHOICE THROUGH A  
VOUCHER PROGRAM.**

**\*BUT TIED TO THESE  
BENEFITS WOULD BE CERTAIN**

**RESPONSIBILITIES, CERTAIN  
RULES. RESIDENTS WOULD  
SIGN A COMMUNITY COVENANT  
SPELLING OUT A ZERO-  
TOLERANCE POLICY TOWARDS  
GUNS AND DRUGS. BEARING  
CHILDREN OUT OF WEDLOCK  
WOULD BE DISCOURAGED.  
NIGHTLY CURFEWS WOULD BE  
IMPOSED. AND COMMUNITY**

**SERVICE WOULD BE AN  
OBLIGATION OF EVERY  
RESIDENT.**
