DR. HALVERSON

(INVOCATION IS DELIVERED)

**THESE ANNUAL DINNERS ARE
ALWAYS TIMES OF MIXED EMOTIONS.
ON ONE HAND, I KNOW WE ARE ALL
ANXIOUS FOR SINE DIE AND THE
OPPORTUNITY TO EITHER RELAX, OR TO
GO HOME AND CAMPAIGN. ELIZABETH
WILL TELL YOU THAT IN MY CASE,
RELAXING AND CAMPAIGNING ARE THE
SAME THING.**

**ON THE OTHER HAND, HOWEVER,
THERE IS ALSO THE REALIZATION THAT
WHEN THE SENATE ADJOURNS, MANY
CLOSE FRIENDS AND COLLEAGUES WILL
NOT BE RETURNING.**

**AS YOU KNOW, NINE OF OUR
COLLEAGUES ARE NOT RUNNING FOR RE-
ELECTION. I DID SOME QUICK ADDITION,
AND FIGURED OUT THAT THE
RETIREMENT OF THESE NINE SENATORS**

**WILL DEPRIVE US OF 139 YEARS OF
SENATE EXPERIENCE--WHICH MEANS
THAT EVEN IF YOU COULD COMBINE
YOUR EXPERIENCE, YOU'D STILL BE
SECOND IN SENIORITY TO STROM
THURMOND.**

DOCTORS--ONE REPOSIBLE FOR OUR
PHYSICAL HEALTH, AND ONE FOR OUR
SPIRITUAL HEALTH--WHO ARE AN**

**IMPORTANT PART OF THE SENATE
FAMILY.**

**DR. ROBERT KRASNER HAS SERVED
IN THE OFFICE OF ATTENDING PHYSICIAN
FOR EIGHT YEARS--THE LAST FOUR OF
THOSE AS ATTENDING PHYSICIAN.**

**IT WAS DR. KRASNER WHO
SUGGEST THAT I GET A PSA TEST...UP

HAVE LEARNED THAT IF THERE'S
ANYTHING MORE DIFFICULT THAN
HEALTH CARE REFORM, IT'S TRYING TO
FIND SOMEONE TO FILL DR.**

**HALVERSON'S SHOES. YOUR WISDOM,
YOUR GUIDANCE, AND YOUR FRIENDSHIP
WILL BE GREATLY MISSED.**

**I CAN'T LET THIS EVENING PASS
WITHOUT SAYING A WORD OR TWO
ABOUT GEORGE MITCHELL. THE SENATE

**SENATOR PACKWOOD INTRODUCED
ME AT AN EVENT IN OREGON A FEW**

**WEEKS AGO, AND HE SAID THAT THE
TOUGHEST JOB IN THE SENATE IS
ARGUING AGAINST GEORGE MITCHELL.
ONCE YOU GRANT GEORGE'S PREMISE,
HE SAID, HE WILL BURY YOU WITH
LOGIC. FORTUNATELY, HE SAID,
GEORGE'S PREMISES ARE USUALLY
WRONG.**

**SO, HEATHER, WHEN YOU HAVE
THAT FIRST DISAGREEMENT AS**

**HUSBAND AND WIFE--REMEMBER NOT TO
GRANT HIS PREMISE.**

**LET ME CLOSE BY SAYING THAT,
AS USUAL, THE SENATE HAS TAKEN ITS
SHARE OF CRITICISM THESE PAST TWO
YEARS. AND I WANT TO CLOSE BY
