

THE EISENHOWER LEADERSHIP PRIZE

The Eisenhower Leadership Prize is an annual award administered jointly by Gettysburg College and The Eisenhower World Affairs Institute to honor an individual whose lifetime accomplishments reflect Dwight D. Eisenhower's legacy of integrity and leadership.

The Eisenhower Leadership Prize awardee receives \$25,000 and a bronze replica of a 1957 bust of Dwight Eisenhower by Nison Tregor.

The recipient of the Prize will contribute to the leadership development of Gettysburg College students through lectures, conferences, or related activities. The Prize has a \$10,000 budget available for such programming, which also includes the recipient's introducing students to other outstanding individuals, examining international conditions that challenge tomorrow's leaders, or taking students to meet his or her colleagues in other nations.

THE 1995 EISENHOWER LEADERSHIP DINNER Recognized as one of our nation's towering leaders, Senator Robert Dole has a distinguished record of public service that has made a difference for America.

Bob Dole was raised in America's heartland, the plains of western Kansas. While a student at Kansas University, in 1943, Bob Dole enlisted and later was assigned to the Third Battalion of the 85th Mountain Infantry Regiment of the legendary Tenth Mountain Division. Dole saw combat as an infantry platoon leader in Italy and in 1945 returned from the second World War gravely wounded. He was twice decorated for heroic achievement with two Purple Hearts and a Bronze Star with Oakleaf Cluster.

Senator Dole finished college at the University of Arizona and received his law degree from Washburn Municipal University in Topeka, Kansas in 1952 graduating magna cum laude from both institutions.


He is one of only 15 Americans to serve as Senate Majority Leader, and has been Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee, a candidate for President, his party's nominee for Vice President, a member of the House of Representatives, the Chairman of the Republican Party, a state legislator, and a county attorney. In 1988, Dole was awarded the Horatio Alger Distinguished American award. Senator Dole is a statesman who has made his mark.

Bob Dole has earned national acclaim for his leadership on behalf of the disadvantaged and Americans with disabilities. In 1983, he established The Dole Foundation to facilitate the economic independence of Americans with disabilities. Throughout the years, more than \$5.4 million in Dole Foundation grants have provided assistance through innovative job training and placement services in rural and urban areas, model assistance technology programs and unique employment services designed for minorities and women with disabilities.

Senator Dole was born on July 22, 1923, in Russell, Kansas. He is married to Elizabeth Hanford Dole, President of the American Red Cross. Senator Dole also has a daughter, Robin, who resides in Washington, DC.

ABOUT THE INSTITUTE

THE EISENHOWER WORLD AFFAIRS INSTITUTE is a nonpartisan organization, dedicated to carrying on the legacy of Dwight Eisenhower's commitment to public service and international understanding by: promoting effective management in the public service; studying and communicating about issues that further international and domestic peace, stability, and justice. The Eisenhower World Affairs Institute accomplishes this mission through the following:

SCHOLARSHIP

★The Graduate Fellowships Program provides grants to doctoral candidates completing their dissertations. Candidates from a dozen universities compete for these prestigious annual awards through The Dwight D. Eisenhower/Clifford Roberts and The Dwight D. Eisenhower/Thomas A. Pappas Graduate Fellowships. The Institute has contributed over \$570,000 to candidates' doctoral theses at the universities of Chicago, Columbia, Cornell, Harvard, Kansas, Princeton, Stanford, Texas at Austin, Tufts, Vanderbilt, Virginia, and Washington.

★The Dwight D. Eisenhower/Conrad N. Hilton Scholarship supports a semester of study abroad for an undergraduate Gettysburg College student.

★The Dwight D. Eisenhower/Ann C. Whitman Scholarship provides for four-year undergraduate scholarships to outstanding students from Perry High School, Perry, Ohio. This scholarship is made possible through a bequest from Mrs. Whitman, who served for many years as confidential secretary to President Eisenhower.

★The Abilene Travel Grants Program assists scholars' research of primary sources at the Eisenhower Presidential Library in Abilene, Kansas. Since the Program's inception in 1983, the Institute has supported 120 researchers who have written on the Eisenhower Presidency and critical events of that era.

★The Eisenhower/Jennings Randolph International Public Works Fellowship supports short-term overseas study projects that offer training and exchange opportunities for U.S. public works professionals.

★The Papers of Dwight D. Eisenhower is a multi-volume reference work chronicling his presidency. The project began in the 1960's, and since 1988, the Eisenhower Institute has provided over \$800,000 in support.

PROGRAMS

*The Ann C. Whitman Domestic Policy Studies Program supports the publication of books, monographs and forums on domestic policy directly linked to the Eisenhower Administration.

★The Whitman/Eisenhower Policy Lectures critically examine major domestic policy challenges and opportunities for the modern presidency.

★The Dwight D. Eisenhower Leadership Development Program is a collaborative effort by Gettysburg College, The Eisenhower Institute and Johns Hopkins University's Paul Nitze School of Advanced International Studies. The Program's goal is to stimulate theoretical and practical study of leadership to foster better understanding of the field and improve methods of teaching critical skills necessary to prepare young men and women to lead.

★The Eisenhower Oral History Program with Eisenhower Administration officials, provides unique opportunities for Gettysburg College students, researchers from Johns Hopkins University and scholars to discuss the policies and challenges faced by the Eisenhower Presidency.

*The Eisenhower Legacy is a three-part television documentary series. The first program, the acclaimed Dangerous Years: President Eisenhower and The Cold War, focuses on international affairs. The second documentary, Contentious Years: The Politics of Change, depicts Eisenhower's domestic policy. Both these programs aired on the Discovery Channel and are hosted by John Chancellor. The last of the series, currently in production, The Last American Hero, examines Eisenhower's life before his White House years. This documentary is also hosted by John Chancellor and will air on The Disney Channel in 1996. Educational modules adapted from the series are under development for classroom use.

*America's Best Foot Forward in China Program is being developed as a joint project between the Institute and the Fudan Foundation in the People's Republic of China. The Program will identify and sponsor representatives of the best in American society for short-term lecturing assignments at the Center for American Studies in Shanghai.

Founded in 1832, Gettysburg College has long been associated with the life and legacy of Dwight D. Eisenhower. When Lieutenant Eisenhower came to Gettysburg in 1918 to command a training base, the College provided housing for the young officer and his new bride. After World War II, Eisenhower returned to accept an honorary doctorate, and during his presidency and retirement, he used several college facilities. Eisenhower also served on the board of trustees and took an active part in the life of the campus.

In recent years the College has launched a number of initiatives designed to strengthen Eisenhower's legacy of leadership. In 1990, the institution hosted the Eisenhower Centennial Celebration, a series of events that attracted President Gerald Ford, Bob Hope, many members of the Eisenhower administration, politicians, political scientists, and historians. During that celebration, the College announced the founding of the Eisenhower Leadership Prize, In 1991, the Eisenhower Institute and the College were affiliated.

The College offers undergraduate degrees in the liberal arts and sciences to 2,000 students from 40 states and 30 foreign countries. The institution is widely recognized as one of the strongest colleges in the nation.

* BILL ROGERS
STANS--AND OF SEVERAL MEMBERS

OF THE EISENHOWER FAMILY.

I HAVE BEEN PRIVILEGED TO GET TO KNOW JOHN ON A NUMBER OF OCCASIONS--INCLUDING EISENHOWER CENTENNIAL ABILENE IN 1990, AND A FEW YEARS AGO IN THE CAPITOL WHEN WE UNVEILED THE SIGN WHICH MARKS THE EISENHOWER INTERSTATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM.

ELIZABETH AND I ARE VERY PROUD TO CALL DAVID AND JULIE EISENHOWER OUR FRIENDS. WE'VE HAD THE **PLEASURE** ALSO OF MEETING THEIR CHILDREN, AND CAN TELL YOU THAT DAVID AND JULIE ARE AS GOOD AS PARENTS AS THEY ARE AUTHORS.

AND MARY EISENHOWER

ATWATER WAS THE ONE WHO CAME

TO MY OFFICE LAST YEAR TO

THE RECIPIENT OF THIS PRIZE. THE ONLY PROMISE I HAD TO MAKE TO HER WAS THAT MY ACCEPTANCE REMARKS WOULD BE BRIEF.

IN FACT, I AM TEMPTED TO DO
THIS EVENING WHAT IKE DID ONE
EVENING WHEN HE WAS PRESIDENT
OF COLUMBIA UNIVERSITY.

AT THE END OF A LONG EVENING OF SPEECHES, EISENHOWER'S TURN CAME. AFTER BEING INTRODUCED, HE STOOD UP AND REMINDED HIS AUDIENCE THAT EVERY SPEECH, WRITTEN OR OTHERWISE, HAD TO HAVE A PUNCTUATION. HE SAID, "TONIGHT, I AM THE PUNCTUATION. I AM THE PERIOD." AND HE SAT DOWN.

HE LATER SAID THAT WAS ONE OF
THE MOST POPULAR SPEECHES HE
EVER GAVE.

ABOUT PRESIDENT EISENHOWER AND HIS LEGACY BEFORE FAMILY MEMBERS AND FRIENDS AND WHO KNEW HIM MUCH BETTER THAN I.

I CAN SAY, HOWEVER, THAT, LIKE COUNTLESS KANSANS AND

COUNTLESS AMERICANS, I NOT ONLY "LIKED IKE," I REGARDED HIM AS A HERO. I WILL NEVER FORGET THE FIRST TIME I SAW HIM. IT WAS THE SPRING OF 1952. I HAD JUST FINISHED LAW SCHOOL, AND WAS SERVING IN THE KANSAS HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

GENERAL EISENHOWER HAD COME
HOME TO ABILENE TO OFFICIALLY
LAUNCH HIS PRESIDENTIAL

CAMPAIGN, AND I WAS IN THE RAIN-SOAKED AUDIENCE THAT GREETED HIM.

THAT CAMPAIGN WAS, OF COURSE, WILDLY SUCCESSFUL. AND I TOOK IT AS A GOOD OMEN THAT MY OFFICIAL ANNOUNCEMENT IN TOPEKA ON APRIL 10 HAD TO BE MOVED INDOORS BECAUSE OF RAIN.

I DID HAVE THE PRIVILEGE OF MEETING MY HERO ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS DURING HIS LIFETIME,
BUT THE TRUTH IS I KNEW HIM NO
BETTER THAN THE OTHER SOLDIERS
WHO CALLED HIM OUR GENERAL,
AND THE MILLIONS OF AMERICANS
WHO CALLED HIM OUR PRESIDENT.

EISENHOWER SUCCEEDED AS A SOLDIER AND AS A PRESIDENT FOR MANY REASONS. INTELLIGENCE. COURAGE. HONESTY. LEADERSHIP. THE ABILITY TO PLACE THE RIGHT

PEOPLE IN THE RIGHT SPOTS. THESE
WERE ALL QUALITIES IKE
POSSESSED.

BUT AS I LOOK AT THE EISENHOWER STATUE IN THE RECEPTION AREA OF MY CAPITOL OFFICE, OR THE PAINTING OF IKE THAT HANGS BEHIND MY DESK, ONE WORD OFTEN COMES TO MIND. AND THAT WORD IS "TRUST."

IKE INSPIRED TRUST AS LEADER HAS BEFORE SINCE. OR MILLIONS OF AMERICANS MAY HAVE VOTED FOR ADLAI STEVENSON IN 1952 AND 1956, BUT EVERYONE TRUSTED PRESIDENT EISENHOWER DO WHAT WAS BEST TO FOR AMERICA.

AND THERE'S A SIMPLE REASON
WHY AMERICA'S CITIZENS TRUSTED
IKE. AND THAT'S BECAUSE HE

TRUSTED AMERICA'S CITIZENS. DON'T GET ME WRONG. PRESIDENT EISENHOWER BELIEVED IN GOVERNMENT--OUR INTERSTATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM IS PROOF OF BUT, MOREOVER, THAT. BELIEVED IN CITIZENS. HE BELIEVED IN THE WISDOM OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE.

WHEN IKE LOOKED AT AMERICA'S
PEOPLE HE SAW HIMSELF.

ACCORDING TO DAVID EISENHOWER, THE TITLE THAT MEANT THE MOST TO HIS **GRANDFATHER WAS NOT "SUPREME** COMMANDER," OR "PRESIDENT;" RATHER IT WAS THE SIMPLE TITLE THAT ALL AMERICANS SHARE: THE TITLE OF "CITIZEN."

AND DAVID REMINDED ME OF A SPEECH IKE MADE IN LONDON THE MONTH AFTER V-E DAY. IKE SAID,

"TO PRESERVE HIS FREEDOM OF WORSHIP, HIS EQUALITY BEFORE LAW. HIS LIBERTY TO SPEAK AND ACT AS HE SEES FIT, SUBJECT ONLY TO PROVISIONS THAT HE TRESPASS NOT UPON SIMILAR RIGHTS OF OTHERS--A LONDONER WILL FIGHT. SO WILL A CITIZEN OF ABILENE."

THROUGHOUT WORLD WAR II, IKE SAW HIMSELF AS SOMEONE WHO WOULD DO WHAT ANY AMERICAN

CITIZEN WOULD DO WHEN FREEDOM WAS AT RISK. AND THROUGHOUT HIS PRESIDENCY, IKE SPOKE OF HOW ALL OF US SHARED WITH HIM THE RESPONSIBILITY OF GUIDING OUR COUNTRY.

AS IKE SAID IN HIS FIRST INAUGURAL ADDRESS, "WE ARE SUMMONED TO ACT IN WISDOM AND IN CONSCIENCE, TO WORK WITH INDUSTRY, TO TEACH WITH

PERSUASION, TO PREACH WITH CONVICTION, TO WEIGH OUR EVERY WITH CARE AND DFFD WITH COMPASSION. FOR THIS TRUTH MUST BE CLEAR BEFORE US: WHATEVER AMERICA HOPES TO **BRING TO PASS IN THE WORLD MUST** FIRST COME TO PASS IN THE HEART OF AMERICA."

WHAT DO THOSE WORDS MEAN IN
THE AMERICA OF 1995?

I BELIEVE THEY MEAN WE SHOULD REDEDICATE OURSELVES TO REMEMBERING THE **DUTIES OF** CITIZENSHIP: TO KEEP INFORMED AND TO BECOME INVOLVED IN THE DECISIONS THAT AFFECT THE LIFE AND FUTURE OF ALL THE CITIZENS OF OUR COUNTRY.

AND THEY ALSO MEAN THAT
GOVERNMENT SHOULD TRUST THE
AMERICAN PEOPLE WITH DECISIONS

THAT MATTER MOST--THE DECISIONS
THAT AFFECT THEIR FAMILIES AND
THEIR BUSINESSES.

TO BE SURE, THE 1950'S WEREN'T PERFECT. AND AS WE LOOK TO THE 21ST CENTURY, WE SHOULD NOT SEEK TO RETURN TO THOSE TIMES. BUT WHAT I HOPE AMERICA CAN RETURN TO IS A RELATIONSHIP OF TRUST BETWEEN THE PEOPLE AND THEIR GOVERNMENT.

AND IF THAT'S TO HAPPEN, THEN REIN IN THE FEDERAL WE MUST GOVERNMENT. IT'S TOO BIG, TOO INTRUSIVE, AND MAKES TOO MANY DECISIONS. I CARRY A COPY OF THE 10TH AMENDMENT WITH WHEREVER I GO. IT'S ONLY 28 WORDS LONG. AND IT BASICALLY STATES THAT ALL POWERS NOT SPECIFICALLY DELEGATED TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT SHOULD BE

GIVEN TO THE STATES, AND TO THE PEOPLE.

DUSTING OFF THAT AMENDMENT,
AND RESTORING IT TO ITS RIGHTFUL
PLACE IN THE CONSTITUTION IS MY
MANDATE AS MAJORITY LEADER,
AND I LIKE TO THINK THAT IT'S A
MANDATE THAT IKE WOULD HAVE
HEARTILY ENDORSED.

PERHAPS IKE SAID IT BEST WHEN
HE RESPONDED TO THOSE WHO

WERE URGING BIGGER AND BIGGER GOVERNMENT, ALL IN THE NAME OF PROVIDING AMERICANS WITH SECURITY.

"IF ALL THAT AMERICANS WANT
IS SECURITY, THEY CAN GO TO
PRISON," IKE SAID. "THEY'LL HAVE
ENOUGH TO EAT, A BED, AND A
ROOF OVER THEIR HEADS.

BUT HE WENT ON TO SAY THAT
CITIZENS WANT MORE THAN

SECURITY. WE ALSO WANT FREEDOM. WE WANT DIGNITY. WE WANT CONTROL OF OUR LIVES. WE WANT OUR GOVERNMENT TO TRUST AND THE LESSON THAT IKE US. TAUGHT US IS THAT IF AMERICAN PEOPLE BELIEVE OUR **GOVERNMENT TRUSTS US, THEN WE** WILL TRUST OUR GOVERNMENT IN RETURN.

AMERICANS ALSO TRUSTED IKE BECAUSE HE TRUSTED US WITH THE TRUTH.

AS SUPREME COMMANDER, IKE NEVER HID THE TRUTH FROM HIS SOLDIERS. IF A MISSION WAS DANGEROUS...IF SOME WOULDN'T BE COMING HOME, THEN IKE LAID IT ON THE LINE. AND, WITH HIS KANSAS CANDOR, HE SPOKE ABOUT ISSUES THAT MANY IN WASHINGTON TODAY

SHY AWAY FROM. ONE OF THOSE WAS THE FEDERAL BUDGET.

HOW MUCH STRONGER OUR
COUNTRY WOULD BE IF OUR
LEADERS TOOK TO HEART THE
PROPHETIC WORDS THAT
EISENHOWER SPOKE IN HIS 1961
FAREWELL ADDRESS TO THE
AMERICAN PEOPLE:

IKE SAID, "AS WE PEER INTO SOCIETY'S FUTURE, WE MUST AVOID THE IMPULSE TO LIVE ONLY FOR TODAY, PLUNDERING FOR OUR OWN EASE CONVENIENCE AND THE PRECIOUS RESOURCES OF TOMORROW. WE CANNOT MORTGAGE THE MATERIAL ASSETS OF OUR GRANDCHILDREN WITHOUT RISKING THE LOSS ALSO OF THEIR POLITICAL AND SPIRITUAL HERITAGE. WE WANT DEMOCRACY TO SURVIVE FOR ALL GENERATIONS TO COME,

AND NOT TO BECOME THE INSOLVENT PHANTOM OF TOMORROW."

MATCHED HIS WORDS WITH ACTIONS. THERE HAVE BEEN FOUR BALANCED FEDERAL BUDGETS IN THE LAST HALF CENTURY. AND IKE GAVE US THREE OF THEM.

HE KNEW THAT IT WAS EASY TO BE POPULAR. IT IS EASY TO SAY "YES" TO EVERY FEDERAL PROGRAM.

BUT HE ALSO KNEW THAT MORE

IMPORTANT THAN BEING POPULAR

FOR A MOMENT IS TO PROVIDE

LEADERSHIP THAT STANDS THE TEST

OF TIME.

ALONG WITH TRUSTING THE
AMERICAN PEOPLE, IKE ALSO
TRUSTED THE VALUES THAT BUILT
OUR COUNTRY, AND THAT WERE
INSTILLED IN HIM BY HIS PARENTS IN

ABILENE. VALUES LIKE HARD WORK.

H O N E S T Y . P E R S O N A L

RESPONSIBILITY. COMMON SENSE.

COMPASSION FOR THOSE IN NEED.

AND, ABOVE ALL, LOVE OF FAMILY,

GOD, AND COUNTRY.

THESE ARE THE VALUES THAT
BUILT AMERICA, AND THEY ARE
VALUES THAT MUST NEVER GO OUT
OF FASHION, OR BE REGARDED AS

"POLITICALLY INCORRECT," BY OUR GOVERNMENT OR BY THOSE IN OUR ENTERTAINMENT INDUSTRY.

ALONG WITH TRUSTING OUR CITIZENS, AND TRUSTING OUR VALUES, THERE'S ONE FINAL LESSON ABOUT TRUST THAT EISENHOWER'S LIFE AND CAREER CAN TEACH US.

AND THAT'S THE FACT THAT THE
WORLD MUST ALWAYS BE ABLE TO
TRUST AMERICAN LEADERSHIP.

THAT'S A LESSON I HOPE WE ESPECIALLY REMEMBERED YESTERDAY, THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF V-E DAY.

THAT BUILT THE ARSENAL OF DEMOCRACY WHICH MADE THAT VICTORY POSSIBLE.

THAT HELD THE ALLIES TOGETHER

DURING THE DARKEST DAYS OF THE WAR.

AND IT WAS AMERICAN
LEADERSHIP WHICH CONQUERED THE
FORCES OF TYRANNY AND RESTORED
LIBERTY AND DEMOCRACY TO
EUROPE.

MAKE NO MISTAKE ABOUT IT,
LEADERSHIP CARRIES A PRICE. IT
DID DURING WORLD WAR II. IT DID
DURING THE EISENHOWER

AS IKE SAID IN HIS SECOND INAUGURAL ADDRESS, "THE **BUILDING OF...PEACE IS A BOLD AND** SOLEMN PURPOSE. TO PROCLAIM IT IS EASY. TO SERVE IT WILL BE HARD. AND TO ATTAIN IT, WE MUST BE AWARE OF ITS FULL MEANING--AND READY TO PAY ITS FULL PRICE."

WHAT THAT FULL PRICE MEANT. HE SAID THAT WHENEVER HE RETURNED TO NORMANDY AFTER THE WAR, HIS FOREMOST THOUGHTS WERE NOT WITH THE PLANES AND THE SHIPS OR THE GUNS.

RATHER, HE SAID, "I THOUGHT OF THE FAMILIES BACK HOME THAT HAD LOST MEN AT THIS PLACE."

I WAS PRIVILEGED TO WALK THE BEACHES OF NORMANDY AND TO RETURN TO THE HILLS OF ITALY WHERE I SAW ACTION DURING THE D-DAY COMMEMORATIONS LAST JUNE. AND I, TOO, THOUGHT OF THE FAMILIES BACK HOME THAT HAD LOST MEN, AND HOW WE MUST NEVER FORGET THE CAUSE FOR WHICH THEY FOUGHT AND DIED.

AND THE ONLY WAY TO ENSURE THAT FUTURE GENERATIONS OF AMERICANS WILL NOT BE BURIED ON FOREIGN LAND, IS TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE LEADERSHIP WHENEVER AND WHEREVER IT IS NEEDED.

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN, I AM
HONORED BY THE CONFIDENCE
BESTOWED IN ME THROUGH THIS
LEADERSHIP AWARD AND WILL DO
MY BEST TO MEET THE HIGH

OF DWIGHT EISENHOWER.

IN CLOSING, I WANT TO SHARE WITH YOU A FEW MORE WORDS OF THIS AMERICAN HERO--AND THEY WERE WORDS HE SPOKE ON THAT RAINY DAY IN ABILENE 43 YEARS AGO.

RETURNING HOME LED IKE TO THINK ABOUT GROWING UP IN

KANSAS, AND HE SAID: "I FOUND **OUT IN LATER YEARS WE WERE VERY** POOR, BUT THE GLORY OF AMERICA IS THAT WE DIDN'T KNOW IT THEN: ALL THAT WE KNEW WAS THAT OUR PARENTS...COULD SAY TO US, "OPPORTUNITY IS ALL ABOUT YOU. REACH OUT AND TAKE IT."

BY WORKING TOGETHER AND TRUSTING ONE ANOTHER, WE CAN

ENSURE THAT FOR GENERATIONS
YET TO COME, AMERICA'S PARENTS
WILL STILL BE ABLE TO SAY THOSE
WORDS TO THEIR SONS AND
DAUGHTERS.

THIS IS WHAT WE OWE TO THE MEMORY OF PEOPLE LIKE DWIGHT EISENHOWER AND ALL THE GI'S OF WORLD WAR II WE REMEMBERED YESTERDAY.

BUT ULTIMATELY, WE OWE IT TO OURSELVES, TO OUR CHILDREN, AND TO THE FUTURE OF THE COUNTRY WE LOVE.



MARY JEAN EISENHOWER ATWATER

Mary Atwater, grandaughter of President Dwight D. Eisenhower, was born at Walter Reed Army Hospital in Washington D.C. on December 21, 1955. She was christened in the Blue Room of the White House in January of the new year. The youngest of the Eisenhower grandchildren, Mary spent most of her childhood in Gettysburg and Valley Forge, Pennsylvania, with the exception of a few years spent in Brussels while her father, John, served as United States Ambassador to Belgium.

Mary and her husband Ralph Atwater IV, are two of several partners of Ground Engineering and Testing Service, Inc., an environmental, geotechnical, and materials engineering firm in Alabama and Kentucky. She also serves as Administrator for Huntsville Construction Services, while her husband, Ralph, is senior materials engineer, and principal partner and chairman of the company's board.

The Atwaters reside in Huntsville, Alabama with their four children: Ralph V, Jason, and twins Courtney and Merrill.

D. DAVID EISENHOWER, II

David Eisenhower is the grandson of Dwight D. Eisenhower. He is a graduate of Amherst College and the George Washington School of Law. Between 1970 and 1973, he served in the Navy as an officer aboard the USS Albany. His tour of duty enabled him to visit some of the places featured in his book, Eisenhower At War 1943-1945, and rekindled his boyhood interest in military affairs. Since late 1976 he has been at work on a three-volume history of the Eisenhower years, of which Eisenhower At War 1943-1945 is the first. For the past eight years he has been a lecturer in political science at the University of Pennsylvania. Mr. Eisenhower, his wife Julie Nixon Eisenhower, and their three children make their home near Valley Forge, Pennsylvania.

JOHN S. D. EISENHOWER

John Eisenhower is the son of General Dwight D. Eisenhower. A graduate of West Point, he was assigned to the First Army during World War II and served with the Third Infantry Division in the Korean War. He completed his military service with the rank of Brigadier General, U.S. Army Reserve.

He aided his father in writing White House Years, edited Letters to Mamie (1977) and authored Allies - Pearl Harbor to D-Day (1982) and The Bitter Woods (1969). He holds a Masters Degree in English and Comparative Literature from Columbia University, 1950.

Mr. Eisenhower has served his country in a number of official and civic areas. He was Ambassador to Belgium from April 1969 to October 1971; Consultant to the President; Chairman of the Interagency Classification Review Committee, May 1972 to March 1973; and Chairman, President's Advisory Committee on Refugees, 1975. He holds a number of Directorships and Trusteeships to educational and service organizations. He and his wife Joanne make their home on the Eastern Shore of Maryland.

DR. GORDON A. HAALAND

Dr. Gordon A. Haaland was appointed the twelfth president of Gettysburg College in 1990. He graduated with a B.A. in psychology from Wheaton College, Illinois, in 1962, and earned his Ph.D. in social psychology from the State University of New York at Buffalo in 1966. Dr. Haaland began teaching as an assistant professor of psychology at the University of New Hampshire in 1959, where he earned tenure and professorial rank. After serving as a visiting professor at the University of Bergen, Norway, he was appointed Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences at the University of Maine, Orono, in 1975. In 1979, he returned to the University of New Hampshire as vice president for academic affairs, and was named interim president in 1983 before being named permanently to the post in 1984.

As president of the University of New Hampshire, Dr. Haaland was responsible for the academic and financial integrity of the institution, and the quality of student life. His accomplishments included general increases in annual giving, successful capital drives, expansion and renovation of facilities, implementation of a general liberal arts requirement and an honors program, and upgrading the quality of student life. He also negotiated several formal agreements with Brazilian universities, which led to scientific and cultural exchanges.

Dr. Haaland is an active scholar who has published numerous articles on social psychology, higher education management, and the behavioral sciences. In addition, he has been active in several professional organizations, and he chairs the New England Board of Higher Education. Dr. Haaland and his wife, Carol, have two children, Lynn and Paul.
