*AND I'D LIKE TO OFFER A FEW WORDS ON THE LEADERSHIP I'D LIKE TO PROVIDE AS YOUR PRESIDENT.

*FIRST, I WOULD REIN IN GOVERNMENT BY CUTTING SPENDING, AND ROLLING BACK **REGULATIONS. WE NEED TO RETURN** POWER TO THE STATES, POWER TO THE CITIES, POWER TO LOCAL SCHOOLS, AND POWER TO THE PEOPLE.

*AND "MIDNIGHT BASKETBALL" WON'T SOLVE OUR CRIME PROBLEM. INSTEAD, WE NEED TO SLAM-DUNK CRIMINALS WITH TRUTH-IN-SENTENCING, SHORTER APPEALS, STRICTER JUDGES, AND PRISONS THAT PUNISH--AND DON'T PAMPER. *AND, THIRD, I WOULD REASSERT AMERICA'S ROLE AS THE LEADER OF THE FREE WORLD.

*MONDAY WAS A BIG, BIG, DAY FOR MANY OF US. IT WAS THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF V-E DAY. AND IF WORLD WAR II TAUGHT US ANYTHING, IT TAUGHT US THE IMPORTANCE OF AMERICAN LEADERSHIP. *AND AS YOU LOOK AROUND THE GLOBE, YOU FIND YOURSELF WONDERING WHERE THAT LEADERSHIP HAS GONE. TAKE BOSNIA FOR EXAMPLE.

*NOW, BOSNIA'S A LITTLE COUNTRY, BUT IT IS A MEMBER OF THE UNITED NATIONS. AND I BELIEVE IT HAS A RIGHT TO DEFEND ITSELF. IT HAS A RIGHT TO PREVENT INNONCENT MEN, WOMEN, AND

CHILDREN FROM BEING SLAUGTHERED. BUT THAT'S NOT GOING TO HAPPEN WITHOUT AMERICAN LEADERSHIP.

*I'M GRATEFUL FOR THE LEADERSHIP THAT SENATOR D'AMATO, GOVERNOR PATAKI, AND MANY, MANY NEW YORKERS ARE PROVIDING TO MY CAMPAIGN.

*ONE THING FOR CERTAIN IS THAT THE REPUBLICAN NOMINEE WILL BE DECIDED BY THIS TIME NEXT YEAR. *AND I'M LOOKING FORWARD TO RETURNING TO THIS EVENT NEXT YEAR, AS THE REPUBLICAN NOMINEE.
